### Summary of purpose and/or changes:

SUMMARY

LB 792 directs DHHS to create a pilot program for assessing and treating post-traumatic stress disorder. The program is funded by a \$25million appropriation from the General Fund.

SECTION BY SECTION SUMMARY:

Sec. 1: The Department of Health and Human Services shall create a pilot program located in a city of the metropolitan class for assessing and treating post traumatic stress disorder. It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate twenty-five million dollars from the General Fund to carry out this section.

Sec. 2: Emergency Clause

# **Explanation of amendments:** AMENDMENT(S)

AM 765 is a white copy amendment that strikes the original sections and inserts:

Sec 1: (1) The Department of Health and Human Services shall create a statewide pilot program for assessing and treating post-traumatic stress disorder through the reduction of community gun violence.

(2) DDHS Shall:

- a. assess community exposure to gun violence
- b. identify treatment services
- c. Ensure pilot program providers use best available procedures and strategies
- d. build a sustainable program beyond the pilot community
- e. conduct periodic evaluations
- (3) It is the intent of the legislature to appropriate \$25million from the general fund
