Sec. 1: DHHS is required to electronically submit a report to the Health and Human Services Committee by November 1 of each year on the current and anticipated expenditures for TANF. Such report shall provide the committee with all necessary and appropriate information to enable the committee to conduct a meaningful evaluation of such expenditures. Such information shall include, but not limited to:

- Clear description of programs and services currently funded by the TANF program;
- A clear explanation of each purpose met by such program or service;
- For programs and services provided by entities other than the state, a clear description of the recipient of TANF funds;
