Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LR 22CA would propose an amendment to Article III, Section 12 of the Nebraska State Constitution to change the limit on legislative terms from two consecutive terms to three consecutive terms.

The proposed amendment would be submitted to the voters at the general election in November 2024.
