Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LR 298 would create the Legislative Oversight Review Special Committee as a special committee of the Legislature. The special committee would be tasked with studying the structure and organization of legislative oversight functions among the various legislative divisions and offices and the structure and organization of legislative oversight functions in other state legislatures. The committee may also study whether current oversight conducted by any statutorily-created board or commission would be more appropriately conducted within the legislative branch.

Under LR 298, the Legislative Oversight Review Special Committee would consist of the following members:

The Speaker of the Legislature;

The Chairperson of the Executive Board;

The Chairperson of the Health & Human Services Committee;

The Chairperson of the Judiciary Committee;

Explanation of amendments:

AM 2637 provides that all members of the Executive Board (voting and non-voting) would be members of the Legislative Oversight Review Special Committee, in addition to the Chairperson of the Health & Human Services Committee, the Chairperson of the Judiciary Committee, and three at-large members of the Legislature.
