Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 308 is the Genetic Information Privacy Act.

Section 2 provides definitions for the Act.

Section 3 requires a direct-to-consumer genetic testing company to take certain actions in order to safeguard the privacy, confidentiality, security, and integrity of a consumer’s genetic data. The Attorney General may bring an action on behalf of a consumer to enforce the provisions of the Act. Violations are subject to a civil penalty of two thousand five hundred dollars for each violation, in addition to actual damages incurred by the consumer, and costs and reasonable attorney’s fees incurred by the Attorney General.

Section 4 exempts protected health information collected by a covered entity or business associate as those terms are defined in 45 C.F.R. parts 160 and 164 from provisions of the Act.

The Attorney General recognizes that, as a new component of Nebraska’s Consumer Protection statutes, additional workload and associated costs will be incurred. These could include items such as: new staffing, office space, OCIO charges, and other legal-related expenses.

The Attorney General anticipates no potential litigation demands.
