**Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.**

LB91 prohibits people from operating or being a passenger on a motorcycle without a helmet, unless they are at least twenty-one years old and have been certified through a basic motorcycle rider course approved by the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV). In addition, LB91 prohibits motorcycle operators on any highway, unless the operator utilizes specified forms of eye protection.

The Department of Transportation (NDOT) estimates they would need to modify signs at state border crossings at a cost of \$24,000. NDOT can accommodate this within existing appropriation resources.

There is no basis to disagree with this estimate.

**Explanation of Estimate:**

LB 91 changes helmet provisions and requires eye protection. If passed, the bill would allow a person who is at least twenty-one years of age and has been certified by the Motorcycle Safety Foundation, or substantially similar, basic motorcycle rider course to be exempt from wearing a protective helmet while operating any motorcycle or moped on any highway in this state. It would also require the operator of a motorcycle or moped to have a form of eye protection.

If this bill passes, the Department of Transportation would need to modify signs at the state border crossings. A replacement of current signs is estimated at \$24,000. This additional expenditure can be accommodated within existing appropriation.
