- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to health benefit plans; to exempt certain
- 2 health benefit plans from insurance regulation.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. (1) A health benefit plan is not insurance and except as

- 2 provided in this section is not subject to any law regarding insurance
- 3 if:
- 4 (a) The health benefit plan provides health benefits under a self-
- 5 funded arrangement administered by an entity licensed as a third-party
- 6 administrator under the Third-Party Administrator Act; and
- 7 (b) The health benefit plan is sponsored by a nonprofit agricultural
- 8 <u>organization or an affiliate of a nonprofit agricultural organization</u>
- 9 that:
- 10 (i) Is domiciled in this state;
- 11 (ii) Was created primarily to promote programs for the development
- 12 <u>of rural communities and the economic stability and sustainability of</u>
- 13 farmers in this state pursuant to its articles of incorporation;
- 14 (iii) Provides membership opportunities for eligible persons in each
- 15 county of this state;
- 16 (iv) Collects annual dues from its members;
- 17 (v) Holds regular meetings to further the purposes of its members;
- (vi) Provides its members with representation on its governing board
- 19 and any committees of such board; and
- 20 <u>(vii) Contracts with the third-party administrator described in</u>
- 21 <u>subdivision</u> (a) of this <u>subsection</u> for administration of the health
- 22 benefit plan.
- 23 (2) Before providing health benefits under a self-funded plan, an
- 24 organization shall file a certification with the Department of Insurance
- 25 verifying that the organization meets the requirements of this section.
- 26 Such certification shall be filed at a time and in a manner prescribed by
- 27 the Department of Insurance.
- 28 <u>(3) The risk assumed by a health benefit plan under health care</u>
- 29 <u>benefit coverage under this section may be reinsured by a company</u>
- 30 <u>authorized to do business in this state.</u>
- 31 (4) Any health benefit plan application for coverage and any

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- 1 contract provided to a member shall prominently state the following:
- 2 (a) The health benefit plan is not insurance;
- 3 (b) The health benefit plan is not provided by an insurance company;
- (c) The health benefit plan is not subject to the laws and rules 4
- governing insurance; and 5
- 6 (d) The health benefit plan is not subject to the jurisdiction of
- 7 the Department of Insurance.
