- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to public health; to amend sections 28-441 and
- 2 28-442, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2022; to provide for
- 3 syringe services programs; to provide for exceptions to penalties
- 4 under the Uniform Controlled Substances Act relating to drug
- 5 paraphernalia; and to repeal the original sections.
- Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) The governing body of a municipality or county may
- 2 <u>authorize</u> by ordinance or resolution a syringe services program to
- 3 operate within the bounds of such municipality or county. A county
- 4 ordinance or resolution shall not be effective within the corporate
- 5 <u>boundaries of any incorporated municipality located in whole or in part</u>
- 6 <u>within the county.</u>
- 7 (2) A syringe services program authorized by this section shall, at
- 8 <u>a minimum, offer or arrange for the provision of the following:</u>
- 9 (a) A needs assessment for program participants;
- 10 (b) Access to sterile syringes, needles, and other items or
- 11 equipment used to reduce the risk of disease transmission or other harm;
- 12 <u>(c) Safe disposal of used syringes, needles, and other items or</u>
- 13 <u>equipment;</u>
- 14 (d) Referral information and educational materials regarding
- 15 substance use disorder prevention and treatment;
- (e) Information to reduce injection and overdose risks;
- 17 <u>(f) Naloxone or information about where naloxone can be obtained at</u>
- 18 <u>low or no cost; and</u>
- 19 <u>(g) Referral information and educational materials regarding social</u>
- 20 <u>services, mental health care, and other health care services.</u>
- 21 (3) A syringe services program authorized by this section shall not
- 22 be located within five hundred feet of any:
- 23 (a) Public or private: Child care facility; elementary, vocational,
- 24 <u>or secondary school; or youth center; or</u>
- 25 (b) Public: Community recreation center, library, or swimming pool.
- Sec. 2. Section 28-441, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 27 2022, is amended to read:
- 28 28-441 (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to use, or to possess
- 29 with intent to use, drug paraphernalia to manufacture, inject, ingest,
- 30 inhale, or otherwise introduce into the human body a controlled substance
- 31 in violation of sections 28-101, 28-431, and 28-439 to 28-444.

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1 (2) Any person who violates this section shall be guilty of an

- 2 infraction.
- 3 (3) A person shall not be in violation of this section if section
- 4 28-472 or 28-1701 applies.
- 5 <u>(4) This section does not apply to:</u>
- 6 (a) The staff of a syringe services program authorized by section 1
- 7 of this act when such staff are engaged in the provision, retrieval, or
- 8 <u>disposal of syringes</u>, <u>needles</u>, <u>or other items or equipment in connection</u>
- 9 with the program; or
- 10 <u>(b) A participant of such a program when the participant is engaged</u>
- 11 <u>in the retrieval or disposal of syringes, needles, or other items or</u>
- 12 <u>equipment at or within the immediate vicinity of the program site or</u>
- 13 <u>facility</u>.
- 14 Sec. 3. Section 28-442, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 15 2022, is amended to read:
- 16 28-442 (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to deliver, possess
- 17 with intent to deliver, or manufacture with intent to deliver, drug
- 18 paraphernalia, knowing, or under circumstances in which one reasonably
- 19 should know, that it will be used to manufacture, inject, ingest, or
- 20 inhale or otherwise be used to introduce into the human body a controlled
- 21 substance in violation of sections 28-101, 28-431, and 28-439 to 28-444.
- 22 (2) This section shall not apply to:
- 23 (a) Pharmacies, pharmacists, pharmacist interns, pharmacy
- 24 technicians, and pharmacy clerks who sell hypodermic syringes or needles
- 25 for the prevention of the spread of infectious diseases; -
- 26 <u>(b) The staff of a syringe services program authorized by section 1</u>
- 27 <u>of this act when such staff are engaged in the provision, retrieval, or</u>
- 28 <u>disposal of syringes, needles, or other items or equipment in connection</u>
- 29 with the program; or
- 30 (c) A participant of such a program when the participant is engaged
- 31 <u>in the retrieval or disposal of syringes, needles, or other items or</u>

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1 equipment at or within the immediate vicinity of the program site or

- 2 <u>facility</u>.
- 3 (3) Any person who violates this section shall be guilty of a Class
- 4 II misdemeanor.
