- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid
- 2 in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 565, One Hundred
- 3 Eighth Legislature, First Session, 2023; and to declare an
- 4 emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$250,000 from the
2 General Fund and \$200,000 from the Nuclear and Hydrogen Development Fund
3 for FY2023-24 and (2) \$250,000 from the General Fund and \$-0- from the
4 Nuclear and Hydrogen Development Fund for FY2024-25 to the Department of
5 Economic Development, for Program 603, to aid in carrying out the
6 provisions of Legislative Bill 565, One Hundred Eighth Legislature, First
7 Session, 2023.

8 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2023-24
9 \$250,000 General Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for such
10 purpose. There is included in the appropriation to this program for
11 FY2024-25 \$250,000 General Funds for state aid, which shall only be used
12 for such purpose.

13 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per
14 diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$12,000
15 for FY2023-24 or \$12,000 for FY2024-25.

16 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$6,000 from the Oil and
17 Gas Conservation Fund for FY2023-24 and (2) \$6,000 from the Oil and Gas
18 Conservation Fund for FY2024-25 to the Nebraska Oil and Gas Conservation
19 Commission, for Program 335, to aid in carrying out the provisions of
20 Legislative Bill 565, One Hundred Eighth Legislature, First Session,
21 2023.

22 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per
23 diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$6,000 for
24 FY2023-24 or \$6,000 for FY2024-25.

25 Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
26 passed and approved according to law.
