- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid
- 2 in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 705, One Hundred
- 3 Eighth Legislature, First Session, 2023; and to declare an
- 4 emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$1,032,345 from the
2 General Fund for FY2023-24 and (2) \$1,516,916 from the General Fund for
3 FY2024-25 to the State Department of Education, for Program 25, to aid in
4 carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 705, One Hundred Eighth
5 Legislature, First Session, 2023.

6 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per
7 diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$278,500
8 for FY2023-24 or \$292,477 for FY2024-25.

9 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$10,000,000 from the
10 School Safety and Security Fund and \$8,500,000 from the Education Future
11 Fund for FY2023-24 and (2) \$-0- from the School Safety and Security Fund
12 and \$8,500,000 from the Education Future Fund for FY2024-25 to the State
13 Department of Education, for Program 158, to aid in carrying out the
14 provisions of Legislative Bill 705, One Hundred Eighth Legislature, First
15 Session, 2023.

16 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2023-24
17 \$18,500,000 Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for such
18 purpose. There is included in the appropriation to this program for
19 FY2024-25 \$8,500,000 Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used
20 for such purpose.

21 There is included in the amount shown as aid for this program for
22 FY2023-24 \$10,000,000 Cash Funds for grants for security-related
23 infrastructure projects.

24 There is included in the amount shown as aid for this program for
25 FY2023-24 \$1,000,000 Cash Funds for the Nebraska Teacher Apprenticeship
26 Program. There is included in the amount shown as aid for this program
27 for FY2024-25 \$1,000,000 Cash Funds for the Nebraska Teacher
28 Apprenticeship Program.

29 There is included in the amount shown as aid for this program for
30 FY2023-24 \$2,500,000 Cash Funds for the Extraordinary Increase in Special
31 Education Expenditures Act. There is included in the amount shown as aid

1 for this program for FY2024-25 \$2,500,000 Cash Funds for the
2 Extraordinary Increase in Special Education Expenditures Act.

3 There is included in the amount shown as aid for this program for
4 FY2023-24 \$5,000,000 Cash Funds for the Nebraska Teacher Recruitment and
5 Retention Act. There is included in the amount shown as aid for this
6 program for FY2024-25 \$5,000,000 Cash Funds for the Nebraska Teacher
7 Recruitment and Retention Act.

8 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
9 for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this
10 section.

11 Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$-0- from the Behavioral
12 Training Cash Fund, \$-0- from the Mental Health Training Cash Fund, and
13 \$-0- from the College Pathway Program Cash Fund for FY2023-24 and (2)
14 \$1,877,616 from the Behavioral Training Cash Fund, \$352,053 from the
15 Mental Health Training Cash Fund, and \$469,404 from the College Pathway
16 Program Cash Fund for FY2024-25 to the State Department of Education, for
17 Program 161, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill
18 705, One Hundred Eighth Legislature, First Session, 2023.

19 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2023-24
20 \$-0- Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for such purpose.
21 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2024-25
22 \$2,699,073 Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for such
23 purpose.

24 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
25 for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this
26 section.

27 Sec. 4. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$-0- from the Door to
28 College Scholarship Fund and \$-0- from the Excellence in Teaching Cash
29 Fund for FY2023-24 and (2) \$234,702 from the Door to College Scholarship
30 Fund and \$1,877,616 from the Excellence in Teaching Cash Fund for
31 FY2024-25 to the Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education, for

1 Program 692, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill
2 705, One Hundred Eighth Legislature, First Session, 2023.

3 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2023-24
4 \$-0- Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for such purpose.
5 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2024-25
6 \$1,883,018 Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for such
7 purpose.

8 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per
9 diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$-0- for
10 FY2023-24 or \$182,100 for FY2024-25.

11 Sec. 5. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$4,894 from the General
12 Fund for FY2023-24 and (2) \$-0- from the General Fund for FY2024-25 to
13 the Board of Trustees of the Nebraska State Colleges, for Program 48, to
14 aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 705, One Hundred
15 Eighth Legislature, First Session, 2023.

16 Sec. 6. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$121,742 from the General
17 Fund and \$54,300 from the Nebraska State Patrol Cash Fund for FY2023-24
18 and (2) \$122,542 from the General Fund and \$36,200 from the Nebraska
19 State Patrol Cash Fund for FY2024-25 to the Nebraska State Patrol, for
20 Program 100, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill
21 705, One Hundred Eighth Legislature, First Session, 2023.

22 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per
23 diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$101,949
24 for FY2023-24 or \$101,949 for FY2024-25.

25 Sec. 7. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
26 passed and approved according to law.
