- Section 1. Section 38-1706, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 3 38-1706 Massage therapy means <u>a health care service involving</u> the
- 4 physical, mechanical, or electrical manipulation of soft tissue for the
- 5 therapeutic purposes or to enhance wellness of enhancing muscle
- 6 relaxation, reducing stress, improving circulation, or instilling a
- 7 greater sense of well-being and may include the use of oil, salt glows,
- 8 heat lamps, and hydrotherapy. Massage therapy does not include diagnosis
- 9 or treatment or use of procedures for which a license to practice
- 10 medicine or surgery, chiropractic, or podiatry is required nor the use of
- 11 microwave diathermy, shortwave diathermy, ultrasound, transcutaneous
- 12 electrical nerve stimulation, electrical stimulation of over thirty-five
- 13 volts, neurological hyperstimulation, or spinal and joint adjustments.
