- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$57,450 from the
- 2 <u>Medicaid Managed Care Excess Profit Fund and \$172,350 from federal funds</u>
- 3 for FY2024-25 and (2) \$-0- from the Medicaid Managed Care Excess Profit
- 4 Fund for FY2025-26 to the Department of Health and Human Services, for
- 5 Program 33, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill
- 6 857, One Hundred Eighth Legislature, Second Session, 2024.
- 7 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
- 8 <u>for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this</u>
- 9 section.
- Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$2,437,489 from the
- 11 Medicaid Managed Care Excess Profit Fund and \$3,986,606 from federal
- 12 <u>funds for FY2024-25 and (2) \$3,443,473 from the Medicaid Managed Care</u>
- 13 Excess Profit Fund and \$5,516,102 from federal funds for FY2025-26 to the
- 14 Department of Health and Human Services, for Program 348, to aid in
- 15 carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 857, One Hundred Eighth
- 16 Legislature, Second Session, 2024.
- 17 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2024-25
- 18 \$2,437,489 from the Medicaid Managed Care Excess Profit Fund and
- 19 \$3,986,606 from federal funds for state aid, which shall only be used for
- 20 such purpose. There is included in the appropriation to this program for
- 21 FY2025-26 \$3,443,473 from the Medicaid Managed Care Excess Profit Fund
