- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid
- 2 in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 905, One Hundred
- 3 Eighth Legislature, Second Session, 2024.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$106,045 from the
- 2 Medicaid Managed Care Excess Profit Fund and \$106,048 from federal funds
- 3 for FY2024-25 and (2) \$216,444 from the Medicaid Managed Care Excess
- 4 Profit Fund and \$216,445 from federal funds for FY2025-26 to the
- 5 Department of Health and Human Services, for Program 33, to aid in
- 6 carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 905, One Hundred Eighth
- 7 Legislature, Second Session, 2024.
- 8 <u>Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per</u>
- 9 diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$50,917
- 10 for FY2024-25 or \$106,924 for FY2025-26.
- 11 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$-0- from the Medicaid
- 12 Managed Care Excess Profit Fund and \$-0- from federal funds for FY2024-25
- 13 and (2) \$133,435 from the Medicaid Managed Care Excess Profit Fund and
- 14 \$1,057,953 from federal funds for FY2025-26 to the Department of Health
- 15 and Human Services, for Program 348, to aid in carrying out the
- 16 provisions of Legislative Bill 905, One Hundred Eighth Legislature,
- 17 Second Session, 2024.
- There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2024-25
- 19 \$-0- Medicaid Managed Care Excess Profit Funds and \$-0- federal funds for
- 20 state aid, which shall only be used for such purpose. There is included
- 21 in the appropriation to this program for FY2025-26 \$133,435 Medicaid
- 22 Managed Care Excess Profit Funds and \$1,057,953 federal funds for state
- 23 aid, which shall only be used for such purpose.
- 24 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
- 25 for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this
- 26 <u>section.</u>
