- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Liquor Control Act; to amend 2 section 53-123.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 3 sections 53-101, 53-103, and 53-123.16, Revised Statutes Supplement, rickhouse; to 4 2023; to define authorize holder of microdistillery license and a holder of a manufacturer's license to 5 6 operate a rickhouse as prescribed; to provide powers and duties to 7 the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission; to harmonize provisions; and 8 to repeal the original sections.
- 9 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 53-101, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2023, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 53-101 Sections 53-101 to 53-1,122 <u>and section 3 of this act</u>shall
- 4 be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Liquor Control Act.
- 5 Sec. 2. Section 53-103, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2023, is
- 6 amended to read:
- 7 53-103 For purposes of the Nebraska Liquor Control Act, the
- 8 definitions found in sections 53-103.01 to 53-103.51 and section 3 of
- 9 <u>this act</u> apply.
- 10 Sec. 3. Rickhouse means an offsite bonded warehouse which is kept
- and maintained for the purpose of storing spirits in barrels for aging in
- 12 order to impart flavor from the barrel into the spirits.
- 13 Sec. 4. Section 53-123.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 14 amended to read:
- 15 53-123.01 (1) A manufacturer's license shall allow the manufacture,
- 16 storage, and sale of alcoholic liquor to wholesale licensees in this
- 17 state and to such persons outside the state as may be permitted by law,
- 18 except that nothing in the Nebraska Liquor Control Act shall prohibit a
- 19 manufacturer of beer from distributing tax-paid samples of beer at the
- 20 premises of a licensed manufacturer for consumption on the premises. A
- 21 manufacturer's license issued pursuant to this section shall be the only
- 22 license required by the Nebraska Liquor Control Act for the manufacture
- 23 and retail sale of beer manufactured on the licensed premises for
- 24 consumption on the licensed premises.
- 25 (2)(a) A licensee who or which first obtains a craft brewery license
- 26 pursuant to section 53-123.14, holds such license for not less than three
- 27 years, and operates a brewpub or microbrewery on the licensed premises of
- 28 such craft brewery license shall obtain a manufacturer's license when the
- 29 manufacture of beer on the licensed premises exceeds twenty thousand
- 30 barrels per year. The manufacturer's license shall authorize the
- 31 continued retail sale of beer for consumption on or off the premises but

- 1 only to the extent the premises were previously licensed as a craft
- 2 brewery. The sale of any beer other than beer manufactured by the
- 3 licensee, wine, or alcoholic liquor for consumption on the licensed
- 4 premises shall require the appropriate retail license. The holder of such
- 5 manufacturer's license may continue to operate up to five retail
- 6 locations which are in operation at the time such manufacturer's license
- 7 is issued and shall divest itself from retail locations in excess of five
- 8 locations. The licensee shall not begin operation at any new retail
- 9 location even if the licensee's production is reduced below twenty
- 10 thousand barrels per year.
- 11 (b) The holder of such manufacturer's license may obtain an annual
- 12 catering license pursuant to section 53-124.12, a special designated
- 13 license pursuant to section 53-124.11, or an entertainment district
- 14 license pursuant to section 53-123.17.
- 15 (3) A holder of a manufacturer's license to manufacture spirits may
- 16 operate a rickhouse that meets the requirements for a distilled spirit
- 17 plant pursuant to 26 U.S.C. 5178, as such section existed on January 1,
- 18 <u>2024, if such manufacturer receives authorization from the commission and</u>
- 19 <u>notifies the commission of the location of such rickhouse in a manner</u>
- 20 prescribed by the commission.
- Sec. 5. Section 53-123.16, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2023, is
- 22 amended to read:
- 23 53-123.16 (1) Any person who operates a microdistillery shall obtain
- 24 a license pursuant to the Nebraska Liquor Control Act. A license to
- 25 operate a microdistillery shall permit the licensee to produce a maximum
- 26 of one hundred thousand gallons of liquor per year in the aggregate from
- 27 all physical locations comprising the licensed premises. For purposes of
- 28 this section, licensed premises may include up to five separate physical
- 29 locations. A microdistillery may also sell to licensed wholesalers for
- 30 sale and distribution to licensed retailers. A microdistillery license
- 31 issued pursuant to this section shall be the only license required by the

- 1 Nebraska Liquor Control Act for the manufacture and retail sale of
- 2 microdistilled product for consumption on or off the licensed premises,
- 3 except that the sale of any beer, wine, or alcoholic liquor, other than
- 4 microdistilled product manufactured by the microdistillery licensee, by
- 5 the drink for consumption on the microdistillery premises shall require
- 6 the appropriate retail license. Any license held by the operator of a
- 7 microdistillery shall be subject to the act. A holder of a
- 8 microdistillery license may obtain an annual catering license pursuant to
- 9 section 53-124.12, a special designated license pursuant to section
- 10 53-124.11, an entertainment district license pursuant to section
- 11 53-123.17, or a promotional farmers market special designated license
- 12 pursuant to section 53-124.16. The commission may, upon the conditions it
- 13 determines, grant to any microdistillery licensed under this section a
- 14 special license authorizing the microdistillery to purchase and to
- 15 import, from such persons as are entitled to sell the same, wines or
- 16 spirits to be used solely as ingredients and for the sole purpose of
- 17 blending with and flavoring microdistillery products as a part of the
- 18 microdistillation process.
- 19 (2) A holder of a microdistillery license may directly sell for
- 20 resale up to five hundred gallons per calendar year of microdistilled
- 21 products produced at its licensed premises directly to retail licensees
- 22 located in the State of Nebraska which hold the appropriate retail
- 23 license if the holder of the microdistillery license:
- 24 (a) Self-distributes its microdistilled products utilizing only
- 25 persons employed by the microdistillery licensee; and
- 26 (b) Complies with all relevant statutes, rules, and regulations that
- 27 apply to Nebraska wholesalers regarding distribution of microdistilled
- 28 products.
- 29 (3) A holder of a microdistillery license may store and warehouse
- 30 tax-paid products produced on such licensee's licensed premises in a
- 31 designated, secure, offsite storage facility if the holder of the

- 1 microdistillery license receives authorization from the commission and
- 2 notifies the commission of the location of the storage facility and
- 3 maintains, at the microdistillery and at the storage facility, a separate
- 4 perpetual inventory of the product stored at the storage facility.
- 5 Consumption of alcoholic liquor at the storage facility is strictly
- 6 prohibited.
- 7 <u>(4) A holder of a microdistillery license may operate a rickhouse</u>
- 8 that meets the requirements for a distilled spirit plant pursuant to 26
- 9 U.S.C. 5178, as such section existed on January 1, 2024, if such licensee
- 10 <u>receives authorization from the commission and notifies the commission of</u>
- 11 the location of such rickhouse in a manner prescribed by the commission.
- 12 (5) (4) The commission may adopt and promulgate rules and
- 13 regulations relating to the distribution rights of microdistillery
- 14 licensees.
