- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to public assistance; to amend section 68-901,
- 2 Revised Statutes Supplement, 2023; to provide for reimbursement of
- 3 doula and full spectrum doula services under the medical assistance
- 4 program; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 68-901, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2023, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 68-901 Sections 68-901 to 68-9,104 and section 2 of this act shall
- 4 be known and may be cited as the Medical Assistance Act.
- 5 Sec. 2. (1) The Legislature finds that: (a) Doula and full spectrum
- 6 doula services have been proven to reduce the cost of birthing and
- 7 improve outcomes for mothers and infants; (b) one of the most effective
- 8 services to improve labor and delivery outcomes is the continuous
- 9 presence of support personnel such as a doula or full spectrum doula; and
- 10 (c) support from a doula or full spectrum doula is associated with lower
- 11 <u>cesarean rates, as well as fewer obstetric interventions, fewer</u>
- 12 <u>complications</u>, <u>less pain medication</u>, <u>shorter labor hours</u>, <u>and higher</u>
- 13 Apgar scores for infants.
- 14 <u>(2) No later than January 1, 2026, the Department of Health and </u>
- 15 Human Services shall reimburse a recipient of medical assistance for
- 16 doula or full spectrum doula services. Such reimbursement shall be paid
- 17 by state funds at rates determined by the department. The department
- 18 <u>shall submit a state plan amendment, if necessary, to provide for</u>
- 19 <u>reimbursement of doula and full spectrum doula services.</u>
- 20 (3) The department shall establish a work group of stakeholders and
- 21 experts to develop an implementation plan, including a reimbursement
- 22 rate, for reimbursement of doula and full spectrum doula services. Such
- 23 work group shall submit the implementation plan to the department no
- 24 <u>later than October 1, 2025.</u>
- 25 (4) For purposes of this section, (i) doula means a trained
- 26 companion who supports another individual through a significant health-
- 27 <u>related experience and may also provide support to the individual's</u>
- 28 partner, family, and friends. The doula's goal, and role, is to help the
- 29 individual feel safe and comfortable, complementing the role of
- 30 healthcare professionals who provide the individual's medical care and
- 31 (ii) a full spectrum doula is a trained companion who provides emotional,

- 1 physical, and informational support for individuals before, during, and
- 2 after labor and birth. This includes, but is not limited to, attending
- 3 prenatal visits, support during delivery, and providing resources during
- 4 <u>the postpartum period. The role of the full spectrum doula is to ensure</u>
- 5 the pregnant person has power in the birth journey. The full spectrum
- 6 <u>doula shall have appropriate training or certification.</u>
