- 4 (1) The That the public interest in the manner in which election
- 5 campaigns are conducted has increased greatly in recent years, creating a
- need for additional accountability and disclosure and accountability; 6
- 7 (2) There That there is a compelling state interest in ensuring that
- the state and local elections are free of corruption and the appearance 8
- 9 of corruption and that this can only be achieved if (a) the sources of
- funding of campaigns are fully disclosed and (b) the use of money in 10
- campaigns is fully disclosed; 11
- (3) It That it is essential to the proper operation of democratic 12
- 13 government that public officials and employees be independent and
- impartial, that governmental decisions and policy be made in the proper 14
- channels of governmental structure, and that public office or employment 15
- 16 not be used for private gain other than the compensation provided by law;
- 17 and
- (4) The That the attainment of one or more of these ends is impaired 18
- 19 when there exists, or appears to exist, a substantial conflict between
- the private interests of a public official and his or her duties as such 20
- official. Although ; and that although the vast majority of public 21
- officials and employees are dedicated and serve with high integrity, the 22
- public interest requires that the law provide greater accountability, 23
- 24 disclosure, and guidance with respect to the conduct of public officials
- 25 and employees.
