- 2 section 81-12,157, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2022; to
- 3 change federal award matching grant and funding limitations as

- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 81-12,157, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 2 Supplement, 2022, is amended to read:
- 3 81-12,157 (1) The department shall establish a phase one application
- 4 program to provide grants to small businesses that qualify under the
- 5 federal grant program for the purposes of planning for an application
- 6 under the federal grant program. If a small business receives funding
- 7 under the federal grant program, the department or a nonprofit entity
- 8 designated by the department may make grants to match up to sixty-five
- 9 percent of the amount of the federal grant.
- 10 (2) Planning grants under subsection (1) of this section shall not
- 11 exceed five thousand dollars per project. Federal award matching grants
- 12 under this section shall not exceed <u>(a)</u> one hundred <u>fifty</u> thousand
- 13 dollars for a business receiving a phase one grant under the federal
- 14 grant program and (b) three hundred thousand dollars for a business
- 15 receiving a phase two grant under the federal grant program. No business
- 16 shall receive funding for more than one project every two years.
- 17 (3) The department may award up to six million dollars per year for
- 18 grants under this section.
