- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to ballot initiatives; to amend sections
 32-630 and 32-1404, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and
 section 49-1401, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2022; to
 provide a restriction relating to payment of petition circulators;
 to prohibit certain contributions to a ballot question committee; to
 harmonize provisions; to provide an operative date; and to repeal
 the original sections.
- 8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 32-630, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 32-630 (1) Each person who signs a petition shall, at the time of
- 4 and in addition to signing, personally affix the date, print his or her
- 5 last name and first name in full, and affix his or her date of birth and
- 6 address, including the street and number or a designation of a rural
- 7 route or voting precinct and the city or village or a post office
- 8 address. A person signing a petition may use his or her initials in place
- 9 of his or her first name if such person is registered to vote under such
- 10 initials. No signer shall use ditto marks as a means of personally
- 11 affixing the date or address to any petition. A wife shall not use her
- 12 husband's first name when she signs a petition but shall personally affix
- 13 her first name and her last name by marriage or her surname. Any
- 14 signature using ditto marks as a means of personally affixing the date or
- 15 address of any petition or any signature using a spouse's first name
- 16 instead of his or her own shall be invalid.
- 17 (2) Each circulator of a petition shall personally witness the
- 18 signatures on the petition and shall sign the circulator's affidavit.
- 19 (3) No person shall:
- 20 (a) Sign any name other than his or her own to any petition;
- 21 (b) Knowingly sign his or her name more than once for the same
- 22 petition effort or measure;
- 23 (c) Sign a petition if he or she is not a registered voter and
- 24 qualified to sign the same except as provided in section 32-1404;
- 25 (d) Falsely swear to any signature upon any such petition;
- (e) Accept money or other thing of value for signing any petition;

- 28 (f) Offer money or other thing of value in exchange for a signature
- 29 upon any petition; or -
- 30 (g) Pay a circulator based on the number of signatures collected.

- 2 32-1404 A signer of an initiative and referendum petition shall be a
- 3 registered voter of the State of Nebraska on or before the date on which
- 4 the petition is required to be filed with the Secretary of State and
- 5 shall meet the requirements of section 32-630. A person who circulates
- 6 initiative and referendum petitions shall comply with the requirements of
- 7 section 32-629 and subsection (2) of section 32-630 and with the
- 8 prohibitions contained in subdivisions (3)(a), (d), and (f), and (g) of
- 9 section 32-630.
- 10 Sec. 3. Section 49-1401, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 11 2022, is amended to read:
- 12 49-1401 Sections 49-1401 to 49-14,142 and section 4 of this act
- 13 shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Political Accountability
- 14 and Disclosure Act.
- 15 Sec. 4. No person, other than an individual, shall make any
- 16 contributions to a ballot question committee totaling more than twenty
- 17 thousand dollars. No ballot question committee shall accept any
- 18 contributions prohibited under this section.
- 19 Sec. 5. This act becomes operative on January 1, 2025.
- 20 Sec. 6. Original sections 32-630 and 32-1404, Reissue Revised
- 21 Statutes of Nebraska, and section 49-1401, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 22 Supplement, 2022, are repealed.
