## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 155**

Read first time January 09, 2023 Committee: Transportation and Telecommunications 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Small Wireless Facilities Deployment 2 Act; amend section 86-1241, Revised Statutes Cumulative to 3 Supplement, 2022; to provide for applicability of a limitation on an 4 authority's power relating to certain activities of a communications 5 service provider; and to repeal the original section. 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 86-1241, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
2022, is amended to read:

3 86-1241 (1) Except as provided by the Small Wireless Facilities 4 Deployment Act or applicable federal law, an authority shall continue to 5 exercise zoning, land-use, planning, and permit-granting authority within its territorial boundaries, including with respect to wireless support 6 7 structures and utility poles, except that no authority shall have or exercise any jurisdiction or authority over the design, engineering, 8 9 construction, installation, or operation of any small wireless facility located in an interior structure or upon the site of any college or 10 university campus, stadium, or athletic facility not owned or controlled 11 by the authority, other than to comply with applicable codes. An 12 13 authority shall evaluate the structure classification for wireless support structures under the standard of the American National Standards 14 Institute found in ANSI/TIA-222, as such standard existed on January 1, 15 16 2019. Nothing in the Small Wireless Facilities Deployment Act shall 17 authorize the State of Nebraska or any agency or political subdivision thereof, including an authority, to require wireless facility deployment 18 or to regulate wireless services. 19

(2) Except as provided in the Small Wireless Facilities Deployment 20 Act or as otherwise specifically authorized by state or federal law, an 21 22 authority may not impose or collect a tax, fee, or rate on a communications service provider authorized to operate in a right-of-way 23 24 by federal, state, or local law for the provision of communications 25 service over the communications service provider's communications facilities in the right-of-way, adopt or enforce any regulations or 26 requirements on the placement or operation of communications facilities 27 in the right-of-way by the communications service provider, or regulate 28 any communications services. This subsection does not apply to the 29 activities of a communications service provider that are outside the 30 31 scope of the Small Wireless Facilities Deployment Act.
