LEGISLATIVE BILL 212

A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to roads; to require the Department of
Transportation to plan, design, and purchase rights-of-way for U.S.
Highway 75 and pave all unpaved state highways; and to declare
legislative intent to appropriate funds.
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. (1) The Legislature finds and declares that:
2	<u>(a) One of the purposes of an expressway system is to connect urban</u>
3	population centers to each other and to populations in rural areas for
4	the benefit of those who commute to urban areas for work and school.
5	<u>(b) The planning, design, and purchase of rights-of-way for a</u>
6	continuous four-lane divided highway system located along U.S. Highway 75
7	from Plattsmouth, Nebraska, and running south to the Kansas border are
8	critically necessary to link southeast Nebraska to Omaha and other parts
9	<u>of the state; and</u>
10	(c) The planning, design, and purchase of rights-of-way described in
11	this subsection will address the growth of global transportation,
12	agribusiness, tourism industries, and significant safety concerns for a
13	growing commuter population in southeast Nebraska.
14	(2) The Department of Transportation shall plan, design, and
15	purchase rights-of-way for a four-lane divided highway system located
16	along U.S. Highway 75 running from Plattsmouth, Nebraska, south to the
17	<u>Kansas border.</u>
18	(3) It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate General Funds
19	for the planning, design, and purchase of rights-of-way for U.S. Highway
20	75 between Plattsmouth, Nebraska, and the Kansas border into a four-lane
21	<u>divided highway.</u>
22	(4) It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate General Funds
23	for the paving or hard-surfacing of all state highways in the state that

24 <u>remain unpaved.</u>
