 section 71-222, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2022; to
 change per diem compensation for board members; and to repeal the
 original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 71-222, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
 2022, is amended to read:

3 71-222 The board shall annually elect a president and vice president, and the board shall appoint a director who shall serve as 4 secretary of the board. The board shall be furnished with suitable 5 quarters in the State Capitol or elsewhere. It shall adopt and use a 6 common seal for the authentication of its orders and records. The 7 secretary of the board shall keep a record of all proceedings of the 8 9 board. A majority of the board, in a meeting duly assembled, may perform and exercise all the duties and powers <u>delegated to</u> devolving upon the 10 board. Each member of the board shall receive a compensation of one 11 hundred fifty seventy-five dollars per diem and shall be reimbursed for 12 expenses incurred in the discharge of <u>such member's</u> his or her duties as 13 provided in sections 81-1174 to 81-1177, not to exceed two thousand 14 dollars per annum. Salaries and expenses shall be paid only from the fund 15 16 created by fees collected in the administration of the Barber Act, and no other funds or state money except as collected in the administration of 17 the act shall be drawn upon to pay the expense of administration. The 18 19 board shall report each year to the Governor a full statement of its receipts and expenditures and also a full statement of its work during 20 the year, together with such recommendations as it may deem expedient. 21 The board may employ one field inspector and such other inspectors, 22 23 clerks, and other assistants as it may deem necessary to carry out the act and prescribe their qualifications. No owner, agent, or employee of 24 25 any barber school shall be eligible for to membership on the board.
