- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Law Enforcement Training
- 2 Center; to amend sections 81-1402, 81-1404, 81-1414.03, 81-1414.05,
- and 81-1414.06, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide for
- 4 another location for the center; to provide for administrators; to
- 5 harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original sections.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. Section 81-1402, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 81-1402 (1) There is hereby created the Nebraska Law Enforcement
- 4 Training Center under the supervision and control of the council.
- 5 (2) The purposes of the training center shall be to (a) (1) test all
- 6 law enforcement candidates on behalf of the council to ensure that they
- 7 meet pre-certification and certification requirements, (b) (2) oversee
- 8 and monitor other training schools and training academies to ensure that
- 9 pre-certification and certification requirements as set by the council
- 10 are being met, and (c) (3) conduct pre-certification programs,
- 11 certification programs, and advanced law enforcement training programs as
- 12 directed by the council.
- 13 (3) The training center shall have two locations at which all of the
- 14 <u>services prescribed by sections 81-1401 to 81-1414.19 are provided. One</u>
- 15 of the locations shall be in Grand Island, Nebraska, and the other
- 16 location shall be in Scottsbluff, Nebraska.
- 17 Sec. 2. Section 81-1404, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 18 amended to read:
- 19 81-1404 (1) The director of the Nebraska Law Enforcement Training
- 20 Center shall devote full time to the duties of the office and shall not
- 21 engage in any other business or profession or hold any other state public
- 22 office. The director shall be responsible to the executive director of
- 23 the commission for the operation of the training center and the
- 24 conducting of training programs.
- 25 (2) The director of the training center shall:
- 26 (a) Appoint and remove for cause an administrator for each location
- 27 <u>of the training center;</u>
- 28 (b) (1) Appoint and remove for cause such employees as may be
- 29 necessary for the operation of the training center and delegate
- 30 appropriate powers and duties to them;
- (c) (c) (2) Conduct research for the purpose of evaluating and improving

- 1 the effectiveness of law enforcement training programs;
- 2 $\underline{\text{(d)}}$ Consult with the council on all matters pertaining to
- 3 training schools, training academies, and continuing education;
- 4 (e) (4) Supervise the administration of the pre-certification
- 5 competency test;
- 6 (f) (5) Ensure that all council rules and regulations with respect
- 7 to law enforcement pre-certification, certification, continuing
- 8 education, and training requirements are implemented and complied with
- 9 and, in that capacity, act as the director of standards for the council;
- 10 (g) (6) Advise the council concerning the operation of the training
- 11 center, the requirements, as set by the council, for all training schools
- 12 and training academies, and the formulation of training policies and
- 13 regulations;
- 14 $\frac{\text{(h)}}{\text{(T)}}$ Issue diplomas to students who successfully complete the
- 15 prescribed basic course of study; and
- 16 (i) (8) Maintain continuing education records in a central registry.
- 17 Sec. 3. Section 81-1414.03, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 18 amended to read:
- 19 81-1414.03 The cost of planning and construction of the Scottsbluff
- 20 <u>location</u> of the Nebraska Law Enforcement Training Center, excluding
- 21 interest on indebtedness of such building and facilities, shall not
- 22 exceed three million six hundred seventy-five thousand dollars plus the
- 23 amount of investment income received by the Nebraska Law Enforcement
- 24 Training Center Fund and by any of the bond or reserve funds established
- 25 in connection with the city of <u>Scottsbluff</u> Grand <u>Island</u> bond issue used
- 26 to finance such building and facilities.
- 27 Sec. 4. Section 81-1414.05, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 28 amended to read:
- 29 81-1414.05 The proceeds of the Nebraska Law Enforcement Training
- 30 Center Fund shall be expended by the commission, as and when appropriated
- 31 by the Legislature, and may to be used for the costs and payments to be

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- 1 made by the State of Nebraska to the city of Grand Island or Scottsbluff
- 2 for the use by the state of such building or facility or portion thereof
- 3 and equipping the same.
- 4 Sec. 5. Section 81-1414.06, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 5 amended to read:
- 6 81-1414.06 It is the intent of the Legislature of Nebraska to
- 7 <u>transfer appropriate</u> to the Nebraska Law Enforcement Training Center Fund
- 8 an amount sufficient for the costs and payments to be made by the State
- 9 of Nebraska to the city of Grand Island or Scottsbluff for the lease by
- 10 the state of the Nebraska Law Enforcement Training Center including an
- 11 amount sufficient for operation and maintenance and lease payments
- 12 sufficient to pay the principal and interest on the bonds issued by the
- 13 city of Grand Island or Scottsbluff to finance such building and to
- 14 maintain any required amounts in any bond and bond reserve funds.
- 15 Sec. 6. Original sections 81-1402, 81-1404, 81-1414.03, 81-1414.05,
- 16 and 81-1414.06, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
