## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 260**

Introduced by Wayne, 13. Read first time January 10, 2023 Committee: Judiciary

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the courts; to amend sections 24-209,
2	24-211, 24-212, 24-1109, 49-506, 49-617, and 49-702, Reissue Revised
3	Statutes of Nebraska, and section 85-177, Revised Statutes
4	Cumulative Supplement, 2022; to designate the Nebraska Appellate
5	Courts Online Library as the repository for published judicial
6	opinions of the Nebraska Supreme Court and the Nebraska Court of
7	Appeals; to provide for sale of extra circulating copies of printed
8	volumes of court decisions; to provide duties for the Reporter of
9	Decisions; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original
10	sections.

11 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 24-209, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

3 24-209 (1) The Nebraska Appellate Courts Online Library shall be the 4 repository for the published judicial opinions of the Supreme Court and 5 the Court of Appeals which have been designated for permanent publication. All previous official bound and printed volumes of the 6 appellate courts' opinions shall be made available on the Nebraska 7 Appellate Courts Online Library. Other distribution of such electronic 8 9 opinions shall be as directed by Unless otherwise directed by the Supreme 10 Court, one copy in print format of the Nebraska Reports and one copy in print format of the Nebraska Appellate Reports shall be furnished by the 11 12 Supreme Court to each judge of the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals, 13 Nebraska Workers' Compensation Court, and district, separate juvenile, 14 and county courts, to each county law library, and to each state library, 15 and two copies of such reports shall be furnished to the Legislative 16 Council. The State Court Administrator shall be furnished as many 17 additional copies in print format as he or she deems necessary for the 18 operation of the Court of Appeals and the Supreme Court.

19 (2) Unless otherwise directed by the Supreme Court, one copy in 20 print format of the opinions of the Nebraska Supreme Court in pamphlet 21 form, known as the Nebraska Advance Sheets, and one copy in print format 22 of the opinions of the Nebraska Court of Appeals in pamphlet form, known 23 as the Decisions of the Nebraska Court of Appeals, shall be furnished to 24 each judge of the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals, Nebraska Workers' 25 Compensation Court, and district, separate juvenile, and county courts, as many copies as may be requested by the members of the Legislature 26 27 shall be furnished to the Clerk of the Legislature, and the State Court 28 Administrator shall be furnished as many copies as he or she deems 29 necessary for the operation of the Court of Appeals and the Supreme 30 Court.

31 (2) As directed by the Supreme Court, extra circulating copies of

previously printed volumes or issues (3) The balance of the Nebraska Reports, Nebraska Appellate Reports, Nebraska Advance Sheets, and Decisions of the Nebraska Court of Appeals <u>may shall</u> be sold as <del>called</del> for at such price and in such format as shall be prescribed by the Supreme Court. The money received from such sales shall be paid into the Supreme Court Reports Cash Fund which is hereby created.

7 (4) Upon request from any office or entity entitled to free copies 8 of the Nebraska Reports, the Nebraska Appellate Reports, the Nebraska 9 Advance Sheets, or the Decisions of the Nebraska Court of Appeals, the 10 court may stop sending the publications to such office or entity until 11 the request is withdrawn.

12 (5) If it is determined by the Supreme Court, pursuant to subsection (2) of section 24-212, that publication of the opinions of the Supreme 14 Court and the Court of Appeals shall be in electronic format, as an 15 alternative to or in addition to print format, the distribution or sale 16 of such print or electronic opinions for purposes of this section shall 17 be directed by the Supreme Court.

Sec. 2. Section 24-211, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

20 24-211 (1) The Clerk of the Supreme Court shall keep his or her 21 office at the State Capitol, be the custodian of the seal of the court, 22 perform the duties devolving upon him or her by law, and be subject to 23 the orders of the court. The Clerk of the Supreme Court shall receive an 24 annual salary to be fixed by the Supreme Court.

(2) The Reporter of <u>Decisions</u> the Supreme Court and Court of Appeals shall keep his or her office at the State Capitol, perform the duties devolving upon him or her by law, and be subject to the orders of the court. The Reporter of <u>Decisions</u> the Supreme Court and Court of Appeals shall receive an annual salary to be fixed by the Supreme Court.

30 Sec. 3. Section 24-212, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is 31 amended to read:

1 24-212 (1) The Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, 2 it shall be the duty of the Reporter of Decisions shall the Supreme Court and Court of Appeals to prepare the opinions designated for permanent 3 4 publication from the Supreme Court and Court of Appeals of the courts for 5 publication in the Nebraska Appellate Courts Online Library advance pamphlet form as soon as feasible. Such opinions fast as they are 6 7 delivered to him or her, and when sufficient material is accumulated to form a volume of not less than nine hundred pages, he or she shall cause 8 9 the same to be printed and bound in a permanent manner. The reporter 10 shall also determine, based on the number of current subscribers and the provisions of section 24-209, the number of copies in print format for 11 12 each publication of advance pamphlets and bound volumes. Payments for 13 such publications shall be made from the Supreme Court Reports Cash Fund. The copyright of each volume shall be entered by the reporter for the 14 15 benefit of the state, and all papers relating thereto shall be filed and 16 recorded in the office of the Secretary of State. The titles of the 17 volumes shall be the Nebraska Reports and the Nebraska Appellate Reports 18 which with the number of the volume shall be printed on the back of each 19 volume, and the reports of every case should show the name of the judge writing the opinion, the names of the judges concurring therein, and the 20 names of the judges, if any, dissenting from the opinion. 21

(2) At The reporter shall also edit and arrange for publication in the statutes of Nebraska, at such times as the Revisor of Statutes may request, the Reporter shall also edit and arrange for publication or electronic release in the statutes of Nebraska, annotations of the decisions of the Supreme Court of Nebraska and the decisions of the Court of Appeals designated for permanent publication and transmit them to the Revisor of Statutes.

(2) In the alternative or in addition to subsection (1) of this
 section, the opinions of the Supreme Court and Court of Appeals may be
 published in electronic format in the manner and under such title

2 Sec. 4. Section 24-1109, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is 3 amended to read:

4 24-1109 The Clerk of the Supreme Court shall serve as the clerk of the Court of Appeals. The Reporter of Decisions the Supreme Court and 5 Court of Appeals shall serve as the reporter of the Court of Appeals. The 6 7 State Court Administrator shall provide facilities, supplies, equipment, and support staff needed by the Court of Appeals. All expenses of the 8 9 Court of Appeals shall be included in the budget of the Supreme Court. 10 The Supreme Court shall adopt and promulgate rules to implement sections 24-1101 to 24-1109. 11

12 Sec. 5. Section 49-506, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is 13 amended to read:

49-506 After the Secretary of State has made the distribution provided by section 49-503, he or she shall deliver additional copies of the session laws and the journal of the Legislature pursuant to this section in print or electronic format as he or she determines, upon recommendation by the Clerk of the Legislature and approval of the Executive Board of the Legislative Council.

One copy of the session laws shall be delivered to the Lieutenant 20 Governor, the State Treasurer, the Auditor of Public Accounts, the 21 22 Reporter of <u>Decisions</u> the Supreme Court and Court of Appeals, the State Court Administrator, the State Fire Marshal, the 23 Department of Administrative Services, the Department of Agriculture, the Department of 24 25 Banking and Finance, the State Department of Education, the Department of Environment and Energy, the Department of Insurance, the Department of 26 27 Labor, the Department of Motor Vehicles, the Department of Revenue, the 28 Department of Transportation, the Department of Veterans' Affairs, the Department of Natural Resources, the Military Department, the Nebraska 29 State Patrol, the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal 30 Justice, each of the Nebraska state colleges, the Game and Parks 31

Commission, the Nebraska Library Commission, the Nebraska Liquor Control 1 2 Commission, the Nebraska Accountability and Disclosure Commission, the Public Service Commission, the State Real Estate Commission, the Nebraska 3 4 State Historical Society, the Public Employees Retirement Board, the Risk 5 Manager, the Legislative Fiscal Analyst, the Public Counsel, the materiel division of the Department of Administrative Services, the State Records 6 7 Administrator, the budget division of the Department of Administrative Services, the Tax Equalization and Review Commission, the inmate library 8 9 at all state penal and correctional institutions, the Commission on Public Advocacy, and the Library of Congress; two copies to the Governor, 10 the Secretary of State, the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Court, the 11 Commission of Industrial Relations, and the Coordinating Commission for 12 Postsecondary Education, one of which shall be for use by the community 13 colleges; three copies to the Department of Health and Human Services; 14 four copies to the Nebraska Publications Clearinghouse; five copies to 15 the Attorney General; nine copies to the Revisor of Statutes; sixteen 16 17 copies to the Supreme Court and the Legislative Council; and thirty-five copies to the University of Nebraska College of Law. 18

One copy of the journal of the Legislature shall be delivered to the 19 Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, the State Treasurer, the Auditor of 20 Public Accounts, the Reporter of Decisions the Supreme Court and Court of 21 Appeals, the State Court Administrator, the Nebraska State Historical 22 Society, the Legislative Fiscal Analyst, the Tax Equalization and Review 23 24 Commission, the Commission on Public Advocacy, and the Library of 25 Congress; two copies to the Secretary of State, the Commission of Industrial Relations, and the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Court; four 26 copies to the Nebraska Publications Clearinghouse; five copies to the 27 Attorney General and the Revisor of Statutes; eight copies to the Clerk 28 of the Legislature; thirteen copies to the Supreme Court and the 29 Legislative Council; and thirty-five copies to the University of Nebraska 30 College of Law. The remaining copies shall be delivered to the State 31

Librarian who shall use the same, so far as required for exchange
 purposes, in building up the State Library and in the manner specified in
 sections 49-507 to 49-509.

Sec. 6. Section 49-617, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
amended to read:

49-617 The Revisor of Statutes shall cause the statutes to be 6 printed. The printer shall deliver all completed copies to the Supreme 7 Court. These copies shall be held and disposed of by the court as 8 9 follows: Sixty copies to the State Library to exchange for statutes of 10 other states; five copies to the State Library to keep for daily use; not to exceed twenty-five copies to the Legislative Council for bill drafting 11 and related services to the Legislature and executive state officers; as 12 13 many copies to the Attorney General as he or she has attorneys on his or her staff; as many copies to the Commission on Public Advocacy as it has 14 attorneys on its staff; up to sixteen copies to the State Court 15 16 Administrator; thirteen copies to the Tax Commissioner; eight copies to 17 the Nebraska Publications Clearinghouse; six copies to the Public Service Commission; four copies to the Secretary of State; three copies to the 18 19 Tax Equalization and Review Commission; four copies to the Clerk of the Legislature for use in his or her office and three copies to be 20 maintained in the legislative chamber, one copy on each side of the 21 chamber and one copy at the desk of the Clerk of the Legislature, under 22 control of the sergeant at arms; three copies to the Department of Health 23 24 and Human Services; two copies each to the Governor of the state, the 25 Chief Justice and each judge of the Supreme Court, each judge of the Court of Appeals, the Clerk of the Supreme Court, the Reporter of 26 27 Decisions the Supreme Court and Court of Appeals, the Commissioner of 28 Labor, the Auditor of Public Accounts, and the Revisor of Statutes; one copy each to the Secretary of State of the United States, each Indian 29 tribal court located in the State of Nebraska, the library of the Supreme 30 Court of the United States, the Adjutant General, the Air National Guard, 31

the Commissioner of Education, the State Treasurer, the Board of 1 2 Educational Lands and Funds, the Director of Agriculture, the Director of Administrative Services, the Director of Economic Development, 3 the 4 director of the Nebraska Public Employees Retirement Systems, the Director-State Engineer, the Director of Banking and Finance, the 5 Director of Insurance, the Director of Motor Vehicles, the Director of 6 7 Veterans' Affairs, the Director of Natural Resources, the Director of Correctional Services, the Nebraska Emergency Operating Center, each 8 9 judge of the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Court, each commissioner of the Commission of Industrial Relations, the Nebraska Liquor Control 10 Commission, the State Real Estate Commission, the secretary of the Game 11 and Parks Commission, the Board of Pardons, each state institution under 12 the Department of Health and Human Services, each state institution under 13 the State Department of Education, the State Surveyor, the Nebraska State 14 15 Patrol, the materiel division of the Department of Administrative Services, the personnel division of the Department of Administrative 16 17 Services, the Nebraska Motor Vehicle Industry Licensing Board, the Board of Trustees of the Nebraska State Colleges, each of the Nebraska state 18 19 colleges, each district judge of the State of Nebraska, each judge of the county court, each judge of a separate juvenile court, the Lieutenant 20 Governor, each United States Senator from Nebraska, each United States 21 Representative from Nebraska, each clerk of the district court for the 22 use of the district court, the clerk of the Nebraska Workers' 23 24 Compensation Court, each clerk of the county court, each county attorney, each county public defender, each county law library, and the inmate 25 library at all state penal and correctional institutions, and each member 26 27 of the Legislature shall be entitled to two complete sets, and two 28 complete sets of such volumes as are necessary to update previously issued volumes, but each member of the Legislature and each judge of any 29 court referred to in this section shall be entitled, on request, to an 30 additional complete set. Copies of the statutes distributed without 31

1 charge, as listed in this section, shall be the property of the state or 2 governmental subdivision of the state and not the personal property of 3 the particular person receiving a copy. Distribution of statutes to the 4 library of the College of Law of the University of Nebraska shall be as 5 provided in sections 85-176 and 85-177.

6 Sec. 7. Section 49-702, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is7 amended to read:

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49-702 It shall be the duty of the Revisor of Statutes:

9 (1) To consult with and assist the Legislative Council prior to each 10 regular session of the Legislature in the preparation of the report of 11 the Legislative Council as to defects in the Constitution of Nebraska and 12 laws of Nebraska and to draft in the form of bills proposed legislation 13 to carry out the recommendations contained in the report;

14 (2) To prepare for submission to the Legislature, from time to time,
15 when recommended by the Legislative Council in its report as to defects
16 in the Constitution of Nebraska and laws of Nebraska, a rewriting and
17 revision, chapter by chapter, in simplified style and phraseology, of the
18 various chapters of the statutes of Nebraska;

(3) To publish annotations of the decisions of the Supreme Court of
Nebraska, the Court of Appeals, and the federal courts as received from
the Reporter of <u>Decisions</u> the Supreme Court and Court of Appeals; and

(4) To prepare, arrange, and correlate for publication, at the end
of each legislative session, the laws enacted during the session and to
arrange and correlate for publication replacements of the permanent
volumes of the statutes.

26 Sec. 8. Section 85-177, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 27 2022, is amended to read:

28 85-177 In order to enable the library of the College of Law to 29 augment its collections, the librarian of the College of Law of the 30 University of Nebraska is authorized to requisition from the respective 31 officer having custody thereof up to one hundred copies of the following

1 state publications: Nebraska Reports, Nebraska Appellate Reports, Legislative Journals, Session Laws, replacement volumes and supplements 2 3 to the Revised Statutes, and Opinions of the Attorney General. The copies of the Legislative Journals and Session Laws may be provided in print or 4 5 electronic format as the Secretary of State determines, upon recommendation by the Clerk of the Legislature and approval of the 6 7 Executive Board of the Legislative Council. The opinions of the Supreme 8 Court and the Court of Appeals may be provided in either print or 9 electronic format, or both, as determined by the Supreme Court.

85-177, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2022, are repealed.
