- 5 allow Department of Health and Human Services employees to use
- 6 justified use of force as prescribed; and to repeal the original
- 7 section.

1 Section 1. Section 83-173, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 3 83-173 The Director of Correctional Services shall:
- 4 (1) Supervise and be responsible for the administration of the
- 5 Department of Correctional Services;
- 6 (2) Establish, consolidate, or abolish any administrative
- 7 subdivision within the department and appoint and remove for cause the
- 8 heads thereof and delegate appropriate powers and duties to them;
- 9 (3) Establish and administer policies and programs for the operation
- 10 of the facilities in the department and for the custody, control, safety,
- 11 correction, and rehabilitation of persons committed to the department;
- 12 (4) Appoint and remove the chief executive officer of each facility
- 13 and delegate appropriate powers and duties to him or her;
- 14 (5) Appoint and remove employees of the department and delegate
- 15 appropriate powers and duties to them;
- 16 (6) Adopt and promulgate rules and regulations for the management,
- 17 correctional treatment, and rehabilitation of persons committed to the
- 18 department, the administration of facilities, and the conduct of officers
- 19 and employees under his or her jurisdiction;
- 20 (7) Designate the place of confinement of persons committed to the
- 21 department subject to section 83-176;
- 22 (8) Establish and administer policies that ensure that complete and
- 23 up-to-date electronic records are maintained for each person committed to
- 24 the department and which also ensure privacy protections. Electronic
- 25 records shall include programming recommendations, program completions,
- 26 time spent in housing other than general population, and medical records,
- 27 including mental and behavioral health records;
- 28 (9) Collect, develop, and maintain statistical information
- 29 concerning persons committed to the department, sentencing practices, and
- 30 correctional treatment as may be useful in penological research or in the
- 31 development of treatment programs;

- 1 (10) Provide training programs designed to equip employees for duty
- 2 in the facilities and related services of the department and to raise and
- 3 maintain the educational standards, and the level of performance, and
- 4 <u>safety</u> of such employees;
- 5 (11) Notify law enforcement agencies of upcoming furloughs as
- 6 required by section 83-173.01;
- 7 (12) Issue or authorize the issuance of a warrant for the arrest of
- 8 any person committed to the department who has escaped from the custody
- 9 of the department; and
- 10 (13) Exercise all powers and perform all duties necessary and proper
- in carrying out his or her responsibilities.
- Sec. 2. <u>The Department of Correctional Services shall provide each</u>
- 13 <u>correctional officer</u>, as part of the standard uniform, with a protective
- 14 <u>vest designed to protect against edged weapons and stabbings. Each such</u>
- 15 <u>vest shall be fitted to the officer.</u>
- 16 Sec. 3. The Department of Health and Human Services shall not
- 17 restrict, in any manner, an employee from exercising justified use of
- 18 force pursuant to sections 28-1409 to 28-1416 to protect such employee or
- 19 others from serious bodily harm or death.
- 20 Sec. 4. Original section 83-173, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 21 Supplement, 2022, is repealed.
