- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Tax Equalization and Review Commission
- 2 Act; to amend section 77-5015, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska;
- 3 to change provisions relating to decisions on appeals; to repeal the
- 4 original section; and to declare an emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 77-5015, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 77-5015 In any case appealed to the commission, all parties shall be
- 4 afforded an opportunity for hearing after reasonable notice. The notice
- 5 shall state the time and place of the hearing. Opportunity shall be
- 6 afforded all parties to present evidence and argument. The commission
- 7 shall prepare an official record, which includes testimony and exhibits,
- 8 in each case, but it shall not be necessary to transcribe the record of
- 9 the proceedings unless requested for purposes of rehearing, in which
- 10 event the transcript and record shall be furnished by the commission upon
- 11 request and tender of the cost of preparation. <u>If the commission has not</u>
- 12 <u>reached a decision on an appeal by the date when the first half of the</u>
- 13 <u>following year's property taxes become delinquent, then the assessed</u>
- 14 value of the property for the year in question shall be reset to the
- 15 previous year's assessed value and shall remain at such value until a
- 16 <u>decision has been made.</u> Informal disposition may also be made of any case
- 17 by stipulation, agreed settlement, consent order, or default.
- 18 Sec. 2. Original section 77-5015, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 19 Nebraska, is repealed.
- 20 Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 21 passed and approved according to law.
