- 2 Commission; to amend section 57-904, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 3 Nebraska; to change provisions relating to the compensation of
- 4 members of the commission; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 57-904, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 57-904 There is hereby established the Nebraska Oil and Gas
- 4 Conservation Commission. The commission shall consist of three members to
- 5 be appointed by the Governor. The director of the state geological survey
- 6 shall serve the commission in the capacity as its technical advisor, but
- 7 with no power to vote. Any two commissioners shall constitute a quorum
- 8 for all purposes. At least one member of the commission shall have had
- 9 experience in the production of oil or gas and shall have resided in the
- 10 State of Nebraska for at least one year. Each of the other members of the
- 11 commission shall have resided in the State of Nebraska for at least three
- 12 years. Initially, two of said members shall be appointed for a term of
- 13 two years each; and one shall be appointed for a term of four years. At
- 14 the expiration of the initial terms all members thereafter appointed
- shall serve for a term of four years. The Governor may at any time remove
- 16 any appointed member of the commission for cause, and by appointment,
- 17 with the approval of the Legislature, shall fill any vacancy on the
- 18 commission.
- 19 The members of the commission shall receive as compensation for
- 20 their services the sum of five not more than four hundred dollars per day
- 21 for each day actually devoted to the business of the commission, except
- 22 that they shall not receive a sum in any one year in excess of four
- 23 thousand dollars each. Such amount shall be adjusted on July 1, 2025, and
- 24 on July 1 of each odd-numbered year thereafter by the percentage change
- 25 in the Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers
- 26 for the two-year period preceding the date of adjustment. In addition,
- 27 each member of the commission shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred
- 28 in connection with the carrying out of his or her duties as provided in
- 29 sections 81-1174 to 81-1177.
- 30 Sec. 2. Original section 57-904, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 31 Nebraska, is repealed.
