- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate federal
- funds to the Department of Health and Human Services for health aid;
- and to declare an emergency.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$5,000,000 from Federal

- 2 Funds for FY2023-24 and (2) \$5,000,000 from Federal Funds for FY2024-25
- 3 to the Department of Health and Human Services, for Program 514, Health
- 4 Aid. The Federal Funds appropriated in this section are from the funds
- 5 allocated to the State of Nebraska from the federal Coronavirus State
- 6 Fiscal Recovery Fund pursuant to the federal American Rescue Plan Act of
- 7 2021, 42 U.S.C. 802, as amended.
- 8 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2023-24
- 9 \$5,000,000 Federal Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for such
- 10 purpose. There is included in the appropriation to this program for
- 11 FY2024-25 \$5,000,000 Federal Funds for state aid, which shall only be
- 12 <u>used for such purpose.</u>
- 13 There is included in the amount shown as aid for this program for
- 14 FY2023-24 \$5,000,000 Federal Funds and for FY2024-25 \$5,000,000 Federal
- 15 Funds for a grant program for a model system of care for individuals who
- 16 <u>have recovered from COVID-19 with persistent symptoms. The grant shall be</u>
- 17 <u>awarded to a rehabilitation hospital with the capacity to provide</u>
- 18 interdisciplinary research.
- 19 <u>The model system of care shall be a comprehensive program to address</u>
- 20 persistent COVID-19 symptoms and include the following activities:
- 21 (1) Post-COVID-19 research;
- 22 (2) Post-COVID-19 clinics;
- 23 (3) Mental health services expanded to address cognitive and
- 24 <u>psychiatric needs of post-COVID-19 patients; and</u>
- 25 (4) Educational materials for health care providers and the public.
- 26 Expenditures from the appropriation to this program shall not be
- 27 restricted to state aid if operating and administrative expenditures are
- 28 <u>necessary</u> to administer the funding appropriated pursuant to this
- 29 <u>section. In such instances, an agency, board, or commission shall be</u>
- 30 reimbursed through the Federal Fund appropriation to the Military
- 31 Department, Agency No. 31, Program No. 191.
