- 2 79-8,143, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2022; to change
- 3 provisions relating to the Alternative Certification for Quality
- 4 Teachers Act; to authorize the Commissioner of Education to issue
- alternative certificates to teach as prescribed; to redefine a term;
- to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original sections.

1 Section 1. Section 79-101, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 4 (1) School district means the territory under the jurisdiction of a
- 5 single school board authorized by Chapter 79;
- (2) School means a school under the jurisdiction of a school board 6

- (3) Legal voter means a registered voter as defined in section 8
- 32-115 who is domiciled in a precinct or ward in which he or she is 9

- 25 (17) Certificate, certificated, or certified, when referring to an
- 26 individual holding a certificate to teach, administer, or provide special
- 27 services, also includes an individual who holds a permit issued by the
- 28 Commissioner of Education pursuant to sections 79-806 to 79-815 or an
- 29 <u>alternative certificate to teach issued pursuant to section 3 of this</u>
- 30 <u>act</u>.
- 31 The State Board of Education may adopt and promulgate rules and

- 6 shall be known and may be cited as the Alternative Certification for
- 7 Quality Teachers Act.
- 8 Sec. 3. (1) In addition to certificates issued pursuant to section
- 9 79-806 to 79-815, the Commissioner of Education shall, subject to the
- 10 provisions of subsections (2) and (3) of this section, issue an
- 11 <u>alternative certificate to teach on a full-time basis to any applicant</u>
- 12 <u>who:</u>
- 13 <u>(a) Possess a bachelor's degree; and</u>
- 14 (b) Has successfully completed an alternative teacher certification
- 15 program operated by an organization that satisfies the following
- 16 criteria:
- 17 (i) The organization operates in at least five states;
- 18 (ii) The organization has operated an alternative teacher
- 19 <u>certification program for at least ten years; and</u>
- 20 (iii) The program requires candidates to pass a subject area exam
- 21 and the pedagogy exam known as the professional teaching knowledge exam
- 22 to receive a certificate under such program.
- 23 (2) A certificate issued under this section only authorizes an
- 24 individual to teach the subject and educational levels for which the
- 25 individual has successfully completed an alternative teacher
- 26 <u>certification program.</u>
- 27 (3) Issuance of an alternative certificate to teach pursuant to this
- 28 section shall be subject to a criminal history record information check
- 29 pursuant to section 79-814.01 and payment of any required fees.
- 30 (4) An individual who receives an alternative certificate to teach
- 31 pursuant to this section shall be subject to the same certification
