1 Section 1. Section 81-1821, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 2 2022, is amended to read:
- 3 81-1821 (1) Except as provided in subsections (3) and (4) subsection
- 4 (2) of this section, no order for the payment of compensation shall be
- 5 entered under the Nebraska Crime Victim's Reparations Act unless:
- 6 <u>(a) The the application has been submitted to the committee within</u>
- 7 the deadline provided in subsection (2) of this section; and
- 8 <u>(b) The</u> within two years after the date of the personal injury or
- 9 death and the personal injury or death was the result of an incident or
- 10 offense which had been reported to the police within five three days of
- 11 its occurrence or, if the incident or offense could not reasonably have
- 12 been reported within that period, within <u>five</u> three days of the time when
- 13 a report could reasonably have been made.
- 14 (2) An application shall be submitted to the committee:
- 15 (a) For a victim who was nineteen years of age or older at the time
- 16 of the personal injury or death, within two years after the date of the
- 17 personal injury or death;
- 18 (b) For a victim who was under nineteen years of age at the time of
- 19 death, within three years after the date of death; and
- 20 <u>(c) For a victim who was under nineteen years of age at the time of</u>
- 21 the personal injury, on or before the victim's twenty-second birthday.
- 22 (3) The committee may evaluate applications submitted beyond the
- 23 deadline established in this section if the committee finds that good
- 24 <u>cause existed for missing such deadline.</u>
- 25 (4) (2) An application submitted by or for a victim of sexual
- 26 assault, domestic assault, child abuse, or sex trafficking is not subject
- 27 to the <u>five-day</u> reporting requirement in subsection (1) of this
- 28 section if, prior to submitting the application the:
- 29 (a) Applicant or victim has reported such crime to the police;
- 30 (b) Applicant or victim has obtained a protection order related to
- 31 such incident or offense; or
