- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to massage therapy; to amend section 38-1706,
- 2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to redefine a term; and to
 3 repeal the original section.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 38-1706, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

38-1706 Massage therapy means <u>a health care service involving</u> the 3 physical, mechanical, or electrical manipulation of soft tissue for the 4 purposes or to enhance wellness of enhancing muscle 5 therapeutic relaxation, reducing stress, improving circulation, or instilling a 6 greater sense of well-being and may include the use of oil, salt glows, 7 heat lamps, and hydrotherapy. Massage therapy does not include diagnosis 8 9 or treatment or use of procedures for which a license to practice medicine or surgery, chiropractic, or podiatry is required nor the use of 10 microwave diathermy, shortwave diathermy, ultrasound, transcutaneous 11 electrical nerve stimulation, electrical stimulation of over thirty-five 12 volts, neurological hyperstimulation, or spinal and joint adjustments. 13
