- 2 Sec. 9. (1) The Department of Administrative Services shall
- 3 develop, maintain, and make available for public inspection on its
- 4 website a database of financial information from all school districts in
- 5 the state. The information required shall include, but not be limited to,
- 6 <u>revenue sources, expenditures, and a balance sheet that contains all</u>
- 7 assets and liabilities for each school district from the most recent
- 8 audit reports filed with the Commissioner of Education pursuant to
- 9 <u>section 79-1089</u>. The budget administrator of the budget division of the
- 10 Department of Administrative Services shall designate an implementation
- 11 <u>date for such database which date is on or before January 1, 2026.</u>
- 12 (2)(a) School districts shall provide to the Department of
- 13 Administrative Services such information from the school district's most
- 14 <u>recent audit report filed with the Commissioner of Education pursuant to</u>
- 15 section 79-1089 as is necessary to develop and maintain the database.
- 16 School districts shall provide updated information to the department on
- 17 an annual basis, and the department shall update the database no later
- 18 than thirty days after receiving any such information.
- 19 (b) School districts shall provide historical financial information
- 20 beginning with calendar year 2005 to the department. Such information
- 21 <u>shall be collected and added to the database if available as soon as</u>
- 22 practicable.
- 23 (3) Nothing in this section requires the disclosure of information
- 24 which is considered confidential under state or federal law or is not a
- 25 public record under section 84-712.05.
