- 3 Section 1. Section 81-2,239, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,
- 4 is amended to read:
- 5 81-2,239 Sections 81-2,239 to 81-2,292 <u>and sections 3 to 9, 11, and</u>
- 6 12 of this act and the provisions of the Food Code and the Current Good
- 7 Manufacturing Practice In Manufacturing, Packing, or Holding Human Food
- 8 adopted by reference in sections 81-2,257.01 and 81-2,259, shall be known
- 9 and may be cited as the Nebraska Pure Food Act.
- 10 Sec. 2. Section 81-2,240, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 11 amended to read:
- 12 81-2,240 For purposes of the Nebraska Pure Food Act, unless the
- 13 context otherwise requires, the definitions found in sections 81-2,241 to
- 14 81-2,254 and sections 3 to 9 of this act shall be used. In addition, the
- 15 definitions found in the code and practice adopted by reference in
- 16 sections 81-2,257.01 and 81-2,259 shall be used.
- 17 **Sec. 3.** Agricultural food animal means any domesticated animal that
- 18 is raised for human consumption or for the production of products that
- 19 are used for human consumption.
- 20 **Sec. 4.** <u>Cultivated-protein food product means a food product having</u>
- 21 one or more sensory attributes that resemble a type of tissue originating
- 22 <u>from an agricultural food animal but that, in lieu of being derived from</u>
- 23 <u>meat processing, is derived from manufacturing animal cells, including</u>
- 24 processes that are part of a manufacturing operation in which one or more
- 25 stem cells are initially isolated from an agricultural food animal, are
- 26 grown in vitro, and may be manipulated.
- 27 **Sec. 5.** <u>Identifying meat term means any word or phrase that states,</u>

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- 1 <u>indicates</u>, <u>suggests</u>, <u>or describes a meat product and includes any:</u>
- 2 (1) Common name for the species of the agricultural food animal
- 3 <u>subject to slaughter and processing, including calf, chicken, cow, goat,</u>
- 4 hog, kid, lamb, pig, poultry, sheep, or turkey;
- 5 (2) Any characteristic of a species of the agricultural food animal
- 6 <u>subject to slaughter and processing, including beef, broiler, cabrito,</u>
- 7 chevon, fryer, lamb, mutton, pork, poulet, veal, or yearling; and
- 8 (3) Common name used to describe a major cut of a meat of an
- 9 <u>agricultural food animal slaughtered and processed, including a major</u>
- 10 <u>meat cut or any other common name that a reasonable purchaser would</u>
- 11 <u>immediately and exclusively associate with a meat product prepared for</u>
- 12 <u>sale in normal commercial channels, including bacon, baloney, bologna,</u>
- 13 bone, brat, bratwurst, brisket, burger, butt, chop, chuck, cold cut,
- 14 <u>cutlet</u>, <u>filet</u>, <u>flat iron</u>, <u>frank</u>, <u>frankfurter</u>, <u>ham</u>, <u>hamburger</u>, <u>hock</u>, <u>hot</u>
- 15 dog, jerky, liverwurst, loin, London broil, lunch meat, New York strip,
- 16 pepperoni, porterhouse, rib, ribeye, roast, salami, sausage, shank,
- 17 <u>sirloin, sparerib, tenderloin, or any comparable word or phrase.</u>
- 18 Sec. 6. Insect-protein food product means a food product having one
- 19 or more sensory attributes that resemble a type of tissue originating
- 20 <u>from an agricultural food animal but that, in lieu of being derived from</u>
- 21 <u>meat processing</u>, is derived from manufacturing insect parts.
- 22 Sec. 7. Manufactured-protein food product means a cultivated-
- 23 protein food product, insect-protein food product, or plant-protein food
- 24 product.
- 25 **Sec. 8.** Plant-protein food product means a food product that:
- 26 <u>(1) Has one or more sensory attributes that resemble a type of</u>
- 27 <u>tissue found in a species of agricultural food animal;</u>
- 28 (2) Is substantially derived from manufacturing plant parts; and
- 29 (3) Does not include any part of an animal that has been
- 30 <u>slaughtered</u>.
- 31 Sec. 9. Qualifying term means a word, compound word, or phrase that

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- would clearly disclose to a reasonable purchaser of meat products that a 1
- food product is not a meat product including cell-cultivated, cell-2
- 3 cultured, fake, grown in a lab, imitation, insect, insect-based, insect-
- protein, lab-created, lab-grown, meat free, meatless, plant, plant-based, 4
- 5 vegan, vegetable, vegetarian, veggie, or any comparable word or phrase.
- 6 Sec. 10. Section 81-2,283, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 7 amended to read:
- 8 81-2,283 (1) No It shall be unlawful for any person shall to
- 9 misbrand any food or distribute, offer for sale, or sell any misbranded
- 10 food.
- (2) A food shall be deemed to be misbranded if: 11
- (a) It does not bear labeling clearly stating (i) the identity of 12
- the food in terms likely to be easily and accurately understood by the 13
- 14 consumer, (ii) the net quantity of contents of the food in terms
- 15 authorized under the Weights and Measures Act, and (iii) the name and
- address of the manufacturer, distributor, or seller of the food; or 16
- 17 (b) Its labeling is false or misleading in any manner; -
- (c) For any manufactured-protein food product that is labeled with 18
- 19 an identifying meat term, such manufactured-protein food product is not
- 20 <u>labeled</u> with a conspicuous and prominent qualifying term in close
- proximity to the identifying meat term; or 21
- 22 (d) For any manufactured-protein food product that is labeled with
- 23 an identifying meat term and offered for sale at a food establishment,
- 24 such manufactured-protein food product is not labeled in a manner that is
- 25 clearly and distinctly separate from any product that is made from tissue
- 26 originating from any agricultural food animal.
- 27 Sec. 11. A manufactured-protein food product is falsely advertised
- if: 28
- 29 (1) All advertising for such manufactured-protein food product that
- 30 lists an identifying meat term does not include a conspicuous and
- prominent qualifying term in close proximity to the identifying meat 31

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- 1 term; or
- 2 (2) For any manufactured-protein food product that is offered for
- 3 <u>sale at a food establishment, such manufactured-protein food product is</u>
- 4 not displayed in a manner that:
- 5 (a) Keeps such product separate from products containing tissue
- 6 <u>originating from agricultural food animals; and</u>
- 7 (b) Uses distinctive shelf tags or other posted representations to
- 8 <u>identify</u> and distinguish such manufactured-protein food product from
- 9 products containing tissue originating from agricultural food animals.
- 10 **Sec. 12.** The department may investigate all credible complaints
- 11 that food products are misbranded or being falsely advertised as meat
- 12 products regardless of whether or not a political subdivision or other
- 13 <u>state agency acts as the regulatory authority for food establishment</u>
- 14 <u>inspections</u>.
- 15 **Sec. 13.** Original sections 81-2,239, 81-2,240, and 81-2,283,
- 16 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
