## **Foreword**

### **To the Senators of the Nebraska Legislature Assembled:**

The Office of the Attorney General (“AGO”) submits the following report on the administration of Neb. Rev. Stat. § 4-201 et seq. (“FATARA” or “the Act”). Section 8 of the Act (Neb. Rev. Stat. § 4-208) requires the Attorney General to report every six months to the Legislature concerning the administration of FATARA, as well as the nature, sources, and content of political propaganda disseminated and distributed by agents of foreign principals from adversary nations or foreign terrorist organizations registered under the Act. This report covers the administration and enforcement of FATARA for the initial reporting period ending March 31, 2026.

FATARA is a disclosure statute that requires persons in the State of Nebraska who are acting as agents of foreign principals from adversary nations or foreign terrorist organizations, and engaged in certain specified activities within the State, to register with the AGO. Section 3 of the Act (Neb. Rev. Stat. § 4-203) defines adversary nations as those listed in 15 C.F.R. 791.4, as such regulation existed on April 1, 2025, and defines foreign terrorist organization as an organization included on the U.S. Department of State’s list of designated foreign terrorist organizations pursuant to 8 U.S.C. 1189, as such section existed on April 1, 2025. Covered persons are required to make periodic public disclosure of their relationships with the foreign principals, as well as to disclose activities, receipts, and disbursements in support of those activities. An important purpose served by FATARA is to inform the government and the people of the State of Nebraska of the identity of persons engaging in activities for or on behalf of adversarial foreign governments, terrorist organizations, and other foreign principals, so that their statements and activities can be assessed in light of their associations.

Throughout this Report on the Administration of the Foreign Adversary and Terrorist

Agent Registration Act (“FATARA Semi-Annual Report”) are summaries of registrations during the covered period which include the activities the foreign agents have engaged in, monies received from and disbursed on behalf of foreign principals, and informational materials disseminated by the agents of foreign principals. The FATARA public search portal is available on the FATARA website, <https://ne.accessgov.com/ago/Forms/Page/ago/fatar-search/>.

The text of this report lists, according to the adversary nation or foreign terrorist organization of the applicable foreign principal, all agents who were registered at any time during the six months covered or who reported for the first time in that period activities, receipts, or disbursements for a previous period. It includes the identities of any agents and their foreign principal(s), a description of the agents’ activities, a total figure for monies received, the nature and source of any political propaganda disseminated and distributed along with a summary of the content, and a listing of all individual agents acting on behalf of foreign principal(s).

As specified by the Attorney General pursuant to the Act, all registrants shall file registration statements and supplements in electronic form using the FATARA Registration Statement Form on the FATARA website. The system enables foreign agents to electronically file documents with the AGO. Electronic filing permits registrants to register online, 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The Act does not place any limitations on the political advocacy activities of an agent, and the AGO’s administration of FATARA is not designed nor intended to inhibit or discourage the expression of political views in any way. Registration under FATARA does not imply recognition by the State of Nebraska of the legitimacy of any particular foreign government or foreign political party. Furthermore, registration does not indicate approval by the State of Nebraska of the activities of registered agents or the content of any informational materials they disseminate.

## **Statistical Summary**

During the initial reporting period ending March 31, 2026, the Office of the Attorney General received zero (0) new registration statements and terminated zero (0) registrations. A total of zero (0) active registrants, representing zero (0) foreign principals, were on file during the period of October 1, 2025, through March 31, 2026. There were zero (0) new agreements with foreign principals reported by agents under the Act, and zero (0) agreements with foreign principals were terminated during this period.

The dollar figure included for each registrant represents the total amount of money received in furtherance of the principal's interests or purpose by agents working on behalf of the foreign principal. This information is based on the registrant's reporting period rather than the calendar year.

The list is compiled alphabetically by adversary nation, then alphabetically by foreign terrorist organization.

The report sets forth the name, address and registration number of the registrant, the identity of the foreign principal, the nature of their activities, the nature and source of political propaganda disseminated during the covered period, a summary of the content of any political propaganda, and the amount of monies received, if any.

## CHINA

During the covered period, no person registered as acting as an agent of a foreign principal from the People's Republic of China, including the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, and the Macau Special Administrative Region.

## CUBA

During the covered period, no person registered as acting as an agent of a foreign principal from the Republic of Cuba.

## IRAN

During the covered period, no person registered as acting as an agent of a foreign principal from the Islamic Republic of Iran.

## **NORTH KOREA**

During the covered period, no person registered as acting as an agent of a foreign principal from the Democratic People's Republic of Korea.

## **RUSSIA**

During the covered period, no person registered as acting as an agent of a foreign principal from the Russian Federation.

## **MADURO REGIME**

During the covered period, no person registered as acting as an agent of a foreign principal from the Maduro Regime.

## **FOREIGN TERRORIST ORGANIZATIONS**

During the covered period, no person registered as acting as an agent of a foreign principal from a foreign terrorist organization.
