SUBJECT: Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) Graduation Requirement
DATE: December 8, 2025

To whom it may concern:

In accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. 79-729, beginning in the 2024-25 school year, a public high school student shall complete and submit to the US Department of Education the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) prior to graduating from high school. Exceptions include the option for:

- 1) A parent or legal guardian to sign and submit a form exempting their student from the requirement
- 2) The school principal or the school principal's designee signing the appropriate form exempting the student to decline to complete; or
- 3) A student who is nineteen years of age or older or is an emancipated minor to sign and submit the form declining to complete.

As part of this requirement, school districts submitted aggregate data on their graduating class denoting the total number of their students who completed, were opted out, or did not comply with the graduation requirement.

There were 244 districts and four special purpose schools reporting data. Below are the statewide results:

- 14,133 students (63.3%) completed the FAFSA
- 8,144 students (36.5%) opted out of the FAFSA
- 0 students did not meet the graduation requirement (i.e., did not complete or were not opted out)

FAFSA Graduation Requirement Report

I. Introduction

Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. 79-729, beginning in the 2024-25 school year, Nebraska graduates from public high schools were required to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), be exempted by a parent or legal guardian, be exempted by their principal, or exempt themselves if they were 19 or older or an emancipated minor. In accordance with this requirement, the Nebraska Department of Education (NDE) was also charged with collecting aggregate information on the number of students at each high school who completed, were exempted for any reason, or did not meet the requirement.

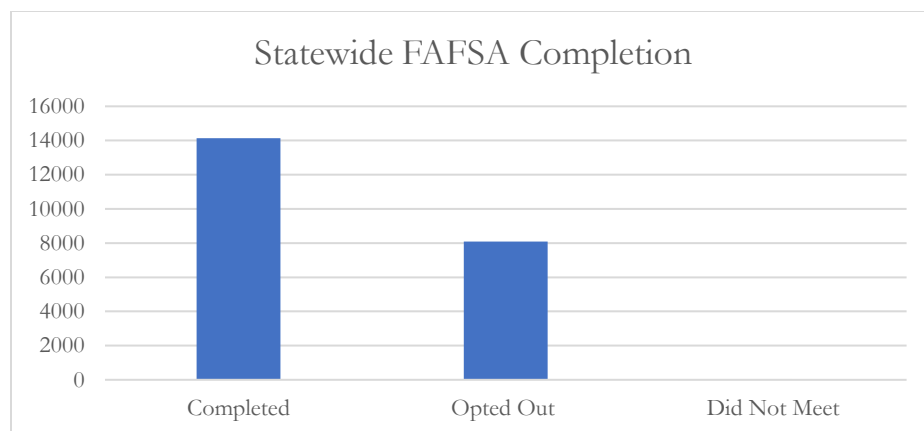
II. Background

The FAFSA informs postsecondary institutions about student eligibility for grants, work-study opportunities, and student loans. In addition, some scholarship providers require information from a student's FAFSA to determine eligibility and award amounts. Financial aid offers based on submitting a completed FAFSA help students pay for educational expenses after high school, reducing barriers to postsecondary education.

In the 2023-24 school year, 48.1% of students in Nebraska completed the FAFSA.¹ As a result, Nebraska's 2024 graduates missed out on almost \$27.6 million in Pell Grants and other federal aid.² As Nebraska works towards its 70% attainment goal,³ attention must be paid by stakeholders across secondary and postsecondary institutions to address access gaps, support the transition from high school to postsecondary, and ensure affordability of postsecondary options. One key step to achieving these goals is FAFSA completion.

III. Data

Data below represent the 2024-25 school year, and specifically the 22,330 graduates. Of the total graduates, all students met this graduation requirement (i.e., they completed FAFSA or were opted out). FAFSA completers represented 63.3% of the graduating class, while 36.5% were opted out.

Specific school- and district-level data are attached to this report. The NDE masks or hides some student data to protect confidential information about students as required by federal law. These masked data will be denoted by *.

IV. Summary

In its first year of implementation, the FAFSA graduation requirement, 63.3% of students completed the FAFSA, and 36.5% opted out. This is almost a 10% increase from the previous year. The students reported in this data would be in their first year of postsecondary, should they have matriculated. Further analysis with other partners should be considered to gain a deeper understanding of the effect FAFSA had on college going, and into the future, postsecondary persistence and graduation.
