These rules are the Commission's general rules of practice and procedure. They govern the process for filing applications, pleadings, investigations, complaints, service of process, ex parte communications, civil penalties and appeal procedures. In large part, the rules mirror the Attorney General's Model rules provided to state agencies. They deviate slightly based upon more specific Commission statutes governing the filing of complaints/investigations, the civil penalty process, and with respect to appeals. These rules assist outside parties in filing applications, interventions or protests, hearing procedures, declaratory rulings, and the ability to appeal Commission decisions.

communication and signaling lines of other facility owners within 1/4 mile of the proposed construction. The Commission is also directed

to confirm that the Department of Aeronautics has no concerns regarding impacts on any airstrips that may be in the project area.

Finally, the Commission must ensure the construction follows the requirements of the National Electrical Safety Code. Once these requirements

are received, the Commission issues a permit to construct, maintain, and operate the line that is valid for two years.
