

- LB 34 (*Hunt*) Provide for year-round daylight saving time
- LB 302 (*Murman*) Eliminate daylight saving time
- LB 123 (*Sanders*) Change provisions relating to withholding money due to noncompliance with budget limits and annual audits for certain political subdivisions
- LB 373 (*Hansen*) Change provisions relating to section lines and vacation or abandonment of public roads
- LB 294 (*Storer*) Change provisions relating to grants from the County Visitors Improvement Fund
- LB 143 (*Rountree*) Change provisions relating to student enrollment
- LB 195 (*Meyer*) Provide immunity for administration of naloxone, nalmefene, or other federally approved opioid overdose reversal medications
- LB 341 (*Hallstrom*) Adopt the Nebraska Statutory Thresholds for Settlements Involving Minors Act
- LB 7 (*DeKay*) Change provisions relating to real estate and the Foreign-owned Real Estate National Security Act
- LB 372 (*McKeon*) Eliminate provisions relating to grain inspections, the Nebraska Origin and Premium Quality Grain Cash Fund, and labeling requirements for honey
- LB 312 (*Strommen*) Provide for student loans to students in nurse anesthesia practice programs and loan repayments for nurse anesthetists under the Rural Health Systems and Professional Incentive Act
- LB 179 (*Clouse*) Change retirement contribution rates for police officers employed by cities of the first class
- LB 501 (*Meyer*) Change provisions relating to the assessment of real property that suffers significant property damage
- LB 592 (*Ballard*) Change provisions relating to the achieving a better life experience program

- LB 390 *(Murman)* Require each school board to adopt a policy relating to access by a parent, guardian, or educational decisionmaker to certain school library information
- LB 135 *(Holdcroft)* Provide, change, and eliminate provisions relating to elections for certain purposes related to bonds and tax levies
- LB 529 *(Jacobson)* Provide certain exemptions relating to contracts for the Nebraska Investment Council under the State Procurement Act and the Taxpayer Transparency Act
- LB 326 *(Jacobson)* Change provisions relating to the Unfair Insurance Trade Practices Act, the Nebraska Property and Liability Insurance Guaranty Association Act, and mutual insurance holding companies and eliminate the provisions of the Health Insurance Access Act and the Health Care Purchasing Pool Act
- LB 457 *(Bostar)* Require anaphylaxis policies for school districts and licensed child care facilities and provide a limit on the amount an insured is required to pay by an insurance policy or benefit plan for epinephrine injectors
- LB 84 *(Rountree)* Adopt the School Psychologist Interstate Licensure Compact
- LB 355 *(Andersen)* Change provisions relating to census data used for certain tax and economic development programs
