LB 1236A (*Hansen*) Appropriation Bill

LB 1210 (*Clements*) Eliminate an obsolete transfer relating to the Cash Reserve Fund

## **SELECT FILE: 2026 SPEAKER PRIORITY BILLS**

- LB 835 (*Jacobson*) Change and eliminate provisions relating to fees of the Secretary of State, notices of liens under the Uniform Federal Lien Registration Act and the Uniform State Tax Lien Registration and Enforcement Act, the central filing system, effective financing statements, the master lien list, and filed records under the Uniform Commercial Code
- LB 1181 (*Bosn*) Change provisions relating to the rights of victims of certain crimes
- LB 727 (*Kauth*) Authorize law enforcement agencies to obtain, maintain, and possess epinephrine autoinjectors and nasal epinephrine for use by a law enforcement officer and require training
- LB 1240 (*Murman*) Change provisions relating to state recovery under the achieving a better life experience program

The following rules apply to Consent Calendar:

- 1) If any five members of the Legislature object to the bill being considered on Consent Calendar, please advise the Clerk in writing. Such requests must be filed with the Clerk prior to the reading of the bill, at this stage of consideration, on the bill to be removed.
- 2) Upon either the completion of debate or the expiration of 15 minutes, whichever comes first, a vote shall be taken to advance the bill and on any pending motions or amendments pursuant to Rule 5, Section 6(d).
- 3) Any amendment adopted, other than the standing committee amendment, which adds new subject matter to the bill will result in the bill not being scheduled at the next stage of debate.

LB 788 (*Bosn*) Change the administrator of the Financial Fraud Victims' Reimbursement Fund from the Attorney General to the Nebraska State Patrol

LB 913 (*Guereca*) Require the Department of Health and Human Services to appoint a dementia services coordinator

LB 784 (*Hallstrom*) Change residency requirements for sheriffs in certain counties and continuing education requirements for law enforcement officers

LB 977 (*Storer*) Provide requirements under the Nebraska Rules of the Road relating to motorists encountering certain animals being led, herded, or driven on or along highways
