- * LB 455 *(Hallstrom)* Change provisions of the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Act relating to injury reports and workers' compensation insurance policies and deductibles
- * LB 525 *(Jacobson, at the request of the Governor)* Adopt the Agricultural Data Privacy Act and the Conversational Artificial Intelligence Safety Act
- * LB 596 *(Sanders)* Change requirements for legal publications and notices required by law, provisions of the Open Meetings Act, county inventories, warrants, and discharge records, storage requirements for certain records, petitions to change names, marriage license and record fees, reports of abandoned property, and the Nebraska Hall of Fame and eliminate a penalty for certain public officials and provisions relating to the registration of farm, ranch, or home names
- LB 764 *(Holdcroft)* Provide for certain Department of Correctional Services employees to be law enforcement officers
- * LB 781e *(Ballard)* Adopt updates to federal law relating to motor vehicles and motor carriers and change civil penalties against certain motor carriers
