Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 1250 creates a new Nebraska statute related to municipalities. The bill authorizes a city of the primary class, first class, second class, or village to sell or transfer any waterworks, sewer systems, or water system to an Indian tribe if the waterworks, sewer system, or water system is located or operating entirely within tribal lands. The sale or transfer would require approval of the qualified electors of the municipality on the ballot via general or special election.
