Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB175 obligates successors in interest of railroad property to provide safe and adequate access to persons owing property on both sides of a railroad right-of-way.

Section 1 - Amends section 74-1335 - Railroad duties

Defines successor in interest as anyone acquiring interests or rights in railroad land. Expands the duty railroads have to provide safe and adequate crossings to anyone owning property on both sides of a railroad's right away to ensure successors in interest of railroad land also retain that duty.

Sections 2 – Repeals original section 74-1335.
