Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 240 would amend the Community Development Law to change a notice requirement for notices of provisions for the division of ad valorem taxes in redevelopment projects utilizing Tax Increment Financing. LB 240 changes the deadline for required notices to on or before July 1 of the year of the provision's effective date. LB 240 includes an emergency clause for immediate effect.

Section-by-Section Summary:

Section 1 amends Neb. Rev. Stat. 18-2147 to require all notices of the provision for dividing ad valorem taxes be sent by the authority to the county assessor on or before July 1 of the year of the effective date of the provision.

Section 2: Repealer.

Section 3: Emergency clause.
