Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill proposes eliminating Daylight Savings Time and remaining on Standard Time year-round in Nebraska. The bill provides for an operative date on January 1 of the year following a similar law change being enacted in Iowa, Kansas, South Dakota, and Wyoming.

Section 2 of the bill contains the operative language, and sections 1, 3, 4, and 5 contain harmonizing changes. Section 6 contains the repealer.
