Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 390 requires each school board in a public school district to implement a policy that ensures parents, guardians, or educational decisionmakers can access specific school library information. The policy must include an online catalog of all books in the district's libraries, organized by school, accessible to parents, guardians, or decisionmakers and a notification system to inform parents or guardians when their student checks out a book, including the book's title, author, and due date. Notifications can be received via a website, app, or email, with the option to opt in.

Explanation of amendments:

AM 97 Amends page 2, line 7 of LB 390 by striking "an online" and inserting "a" in its place.
