Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 518 amends Section 83-1,100.03 of the Nebraska Treatment and Corrections Act to change a report requirement by the Department of Correctional Services and the Board of Parole to include certain prescribed parole data.

LB 518 specifically requires that the report contain information regarding the number of inmates eligible for parole who remain incarcerated, disaggregated by reason for such status; revocations of parole during the preceding year, disaggregated by the reason for revocation; hearings to grant or revoke parole conducted in the preceding year; rehabilitation and recidivism of parolees; cost savings to the state resulting from individuals being paroled rather than incarcerated; as well as other matters the director deems appropriate.
