Section 1:

LB 640 amends Section 47-502 to require using the aggregate of the remaining term of a person sentenced to or confined in a city or county jail, including the sum of all consecutive sentences the person receives, whether received at the same time or at any time during such sentence or confinement, in determining sentence or sanction reduction.
