Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 709 adopts the Adoption Tax Credit Act, allowing an eligible taxpayer a refundable income tax credit equal to ten percent (10%) of the federal adoption expenses tax credit provided in 26 U.S.C. 23 and authorizes the Department of Revenue establish rules and regulations needed to carry out the Act.

Section by Section Summary.

Section 1. Creates a new statute that provides the citation and title of the Adoption Tax Credit Act.

Section 2. Creates a new statute providing for a new income tax credit for anyone eligible for the federal adoption expenses tax credit and establishing the tax credit as refundable and equal to ten percent (10%) of the allowed federal income tax credit.

Section 3. Creates a new statute allowing the Department of Revenue to establish rules and regulations to carry out the Adoption Tax Credit Act.

Section 4. Amends Neb. Rev. Stat. § 77-2715.07 to harmonize provisions with the Adoption Tax Credit Act.

Section 5. Repealer.
