Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LR20CA proposes an amendment to Article III, Section 24 of Nebraska's constitution, allowing gaming operators at licensed racetracks in Nebraska to offer sports wagering through mobile platforms, provided the bettor is located within Nebraska when placing the wager. LR20CA revenue will be directed to the Property Tax Credit Fund.

SECTION BY SECTION SUMMARY:

Section 1: The proposed amendment to the Constitution will be placed on the ballot for the November 2026 general election.

Article III, section 24, subsection five, is amended to provide that any authorized gaming operator conducting sports wagering within a licensed racetrack enclosure may allow a sports wager to be placed by means of a mobile or electronic platform that is offered by or in partnership with such authorized gaming operator as long as the individual placing the sports wager is located inside the State of Nebraska at the time the sports wager is placed.

Section 2: Includes ballot language for the proposed constitutional amendment: "A constitutional amendment to permit an authorized gaming operator conducting sports wagering within a licensed racetrack enclosure to allow a sports wager to be placed by an individual located within the State of Nebraska at the time the individual places the sports wager by means of a mobile or electronic platform."
