LB140 would require each school board of a public school district to develop & adopt a policy relating to use of electronic communication devices by students.

Prior to the 2025-26 school year, each school board of a public school district will adopt a policy that establishes rules & standards concerning use of electronic communication devices by students while on school property or attending a school function. The development of the policy will include stakeholder participation to ensure that the policies are responsive to the unique needs & desires of students, parents, & educators in each community.

This policy:

- will prohibit the use of an electronic communication device by students while on school property or attending a school function
- can include student discipline & enforcement mechanisms that limit access to cell phones by students only if the school board adopts the policy as part of the rules & standards adopted in accordance with the requirements of §79-262

The adopted policy will not prohibit a student from using an electronic communication device while on school property or attending a school function under any of the following circumstances:

- when required by a student's individualized education program & 504 plan
- when authorized by a teacher for educational purposes during instructional time
- in the case of an emergency or perceived threat of danger
- when necessary to monitor or manage a student's health care
- when determined appropriate by the school board or otherwise allowed by an appropriate school employee

AM203 updates the following language:

- school function to instructional function
- cell phones to electronic communication devices
- a teacher to the school district
- electronic communicating device to electronic communication device

Since an emergency exists, this bill will take effect when passed & approved according to law.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB140 would require school districts to adopt a policy establishing rules and standards concerning the use of electronic communication devices by students while on school property or attending a school function. There would be no fiscal impact to the NDE.

A NDE survey from November 2024 indicated that 178 school districts already had a policy in place on the topic. The remaining school boards that do not have a policy would incur some costs which are undeterminable.

With AM203, there are no additional fiscal impacts.
