Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 32 would allow for the use of a post office box address instead of a street address on the Nebraska Disclosure and Accountability Commission (NADC) required disclaimer on printed materials pertaining to a candidate or ballot question. Under the bill, a street address would still be on file with the NADC and required on any reports and filings, but a PO box could be used on any disclaimers distributed to the public.

The bill, as amended by AM 254, adds additional disclosure requirements regarding the use of self-funding for materials relating to each candidate and materials related to advertisement.

The Nebraska Accountability and Disclosure Commission anticipates that they would incur one-time costs of \$1,000 for reprinting forms and instructional materials. Additionally, the Commission would have one-time costs of \$1,000 for the notification and education of persons subject to the amended provision. NADC anticipates that these costs can be absorbed with the agency’s current resources.
