Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

This bill requires coverage for self-measure blood pressure monitors and associated services under the medical assistance program, Medicaid, no later than January 1, 2026 which creates a timing issue in the 2026 session. This fiscal note assumes coverage no later than January 1, 2027.

The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) estimates the costs of including this service is \$183,300 for a full year. This estimate is based on 705 clients taking up the service, \$80 for the device, and \$15 monthly service fee. The fiscal impact appears to be reasonable; Blood-pressure monitors would not necessarily need annual replacement however the devices would need to be purchased for each new client and the devices would degrade over time. DHHS utilizes a fund mix assumption of 61.81% for FY27 based on a blended Federal Medical Assistance Percentage (FMAP) that combines higher federal participation for the Medicaid expansion population and a lower federal participation for regular Medicaid.
